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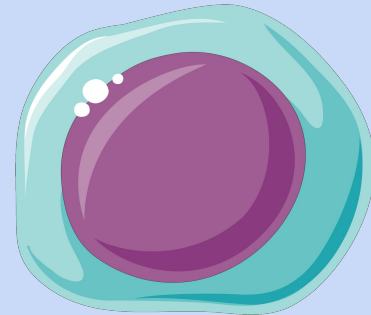
WHO AM I?

- I love working out like, running, yoga, cycling

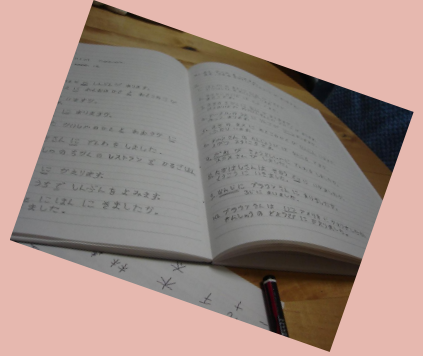

Be Responsible

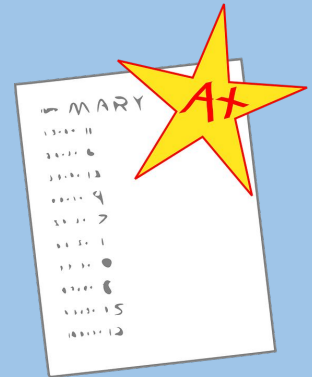
- Use technology responsibly

- *Coming to class unprepared will result in a three point deduction off your classwork grade.

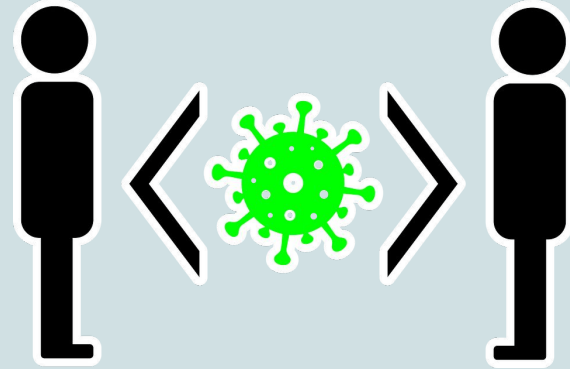
CLASS RULES
