ADVENTURES IN KEYBOARD

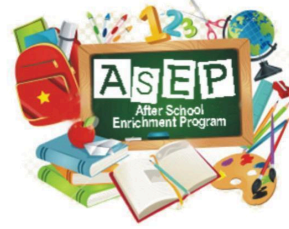
