

3rd Annual Veterans Assembly



Pumpkin Decorating Contest Grades Nursery - 8th grade

Directions

- 1. Students need to design and decorate a pumpkin that showcases a character. For ideas & inspiration you can go to the library or online.
- 2. The main part of your entry must be a pumpkin, but the rest of the decorations (paint, glue, fabric, yarn, glitter, etc.) are up to your imagination.
- 3 .You must use a real pumpkin.
- 4. All students need to supply their own pumpkin. Pumpkins can be no larger than a soccer ball.

NO CARVED OR HOLLOWED OUT PUMPKINS WILL BE ACCEPTED! (Carved pumpkins rot, attract bugs & do not have a pleasant odor.)

5. All submissions should be brought to school on Monday, October 30th. PLEASE BE SURE YOUR PUMPKIN HAS YOUR NAME AND CLASS ON IT.

- 6. Students must be able to carry the pumpkin into school without assistance. Younger students may want to choose smaller pumpkins.
- 7. A Faculty Committee will judge the contest.
- 8. Pumpkins will be sent home on Friday, October 31st.
