We are also excited to share that we have again planned for students in each grade 3-8 to engage in an "in-house" Advent Retreat. Each grade, according to the following schedule, will attend Mass together at 9:00 AM in the Chapel, and then be escorted to the St. Francis Ministry Center, where they will participate in a series of Advent and faith-themed discussions and activities Lunch will be provided there as well. They will then return to the Church to end their day with Eucharistic Adoration. Father Joe Catafago has worked hard planning, and will facilitate these full-day retreats. (Arrival and dismissal are normal on these days):

Friday, December 12th Grade 5

We expect that through these retreats, our students will experience and reflect upon the true meaning of Advent and the Christmas season, growing in their faith, and their appreciation and love for God and their families.
