Please remind the children to dress accordingly, no ripped jeans, cropped shirts or miniskirts.



ST. ANNE'S SUMMER LITERACY ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

A very generous donation to the Parish is allowing us to offer a Summer Literacy Enrichment Program to the children of St. Anne's School and the children of St. Anne's Parish who attend the Faith Formation Program. The program will be held at the St. Francis Ministry Center on the campus of St. Anne's Parish.

Each Course meets Monday - Thursday, 9-11 am.
DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION IS MARCH 30th

Literacy Skills Support "Building a Strong Foundation"

- Designed specifically for children entering grades 1 through 6 who struggle with aspects of reading and writing. Teachers design fun and engaging learning activities that will target and strengthen specific literacy skills.
- This program is a 3-week commitment, July 6th-23rd, or July 27th - Aug 13th. Students registered for this program will be invited for a literacy screening in early June to ensure targeted skill-development utilizing science of reading / multi-sensory methodology.
- Age groupings:
Students entering grade 1 and 2
Students entering grade 3 and 4
Students entering grade 5 and 6
- \$300 fee per child

Literacy Enrichment "Read and Reflect"

- Designed for students entering grade 1 through 8 who demonstrate grade-level proficiency, but would benefit from the opportunity to further enhance and strengthen their love of reading and writing. Students will experience reading a variety of genres, with opportunities to create and prepare written and oral reflections with their classmates.
- This program is a 2-week commitment: July 6th - 16th, July 20th-30th or Aug 3rd-13th
- Age groupings:
Students entering grade 1 and 2
Students entering grade 3 and 4
Students entering grade 5 - 8
- \$200 fee per child

Public Speaking Boot Camp

- Designed for students entering grades 5 through 8 who wish to learn and practice the art and skills of public speaking, including debate, extemporaneous speech and broadcasting.
- The program is a 2-week commitment: July 6th-16th, July 20th-30th, or Aug 3rd-13th.
- \$200 fee per child

Writer's Workshop

- Designed for students entering grades 3 through 8 who are interested in enhancing their writing skills through activities that promote a variety of formal and informal writing formats and genres including creative and expressive writing.
- The program is a 2-week commitment: July 6th-16th, July 20th-30th, or Aug 3rd-13th
- Age groupings:
Students entering grade 3 through 5
Students entering grade 6 through 8
- \$200 fee per child


