St. Anne's School in collaboration with Catholic Health Services (CHS), is bringing incredible new opportunities to our students and enriching our school community.

Last Tuesday, a Medical Boot Camp ran from 9:00 to 11:30AM. This hands-on experience allowed our 8th grade Regents Living Environment students to engage directly with physicians and medical professionals from Good Samaritan Hospital. Students rotated through a series of interactive stations, gaining first hand exposure to the medical field and deepening their understanding of key biological and health concepts, using the very equipment used to train current residents and fellows at the hospital, including ultrasound, prosthetics, suturing and laparoscopic, minimally-invasive surgical procedures.

As part of this ongoing partnership, additional events, guest speakers and activities were planned for this year and beyond, all aimed at enhancing the educational experience for St. Anne's students. St. Anne's School and Catholic Health Services are excited to partner on this and look forward to continuing and expanding a relationship that will benefit our students.
