

2025-2026 Fourth Grade Supply List

Dear Families,

The following is a list of supplies your child will need in 4th grade. All hardcover books must be covered with heavy paper or book sox. Softcover workbooks should be covered with clear contact. Your child's first and last name must be on the inside cover of all books, as well as the front cover of the workbooks. Please buy the brands listed on the supply list, and label all supplies with your child's name. Additional supplies may be requested throughout the year. Thank you!

Personal Student supplies :

- 1 Backpack (No wheels)
- 1 plastic Home folder with horizontal pockets along bottom
- 1 plastic School folder with horizontal pockets along bottom
- 2 Mead 3 subject spiral notebooks (Must have the pocket folders dividing each subject) **Label one ELA/SS and the other Math/Science**
- 1 set of headphones - Put in a Ziplock bag with your child's name
- 1 lunchbox
- 1 reusable water bottle

The following supplies should be put in a soft pencil case and replenished as needed:

- 6 sharpened #2 pencils
- 1 large pink eraser (not the pencil toppers)
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- 1 colored pen - used for self-correcting/editing classwork (Not black or blue)
- 1 black Sharpie marker
- 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 box of Crayola colored pencils (12 count)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 3 Elmer's glue sticks

*Please do **not** include pencil sharpeners.
