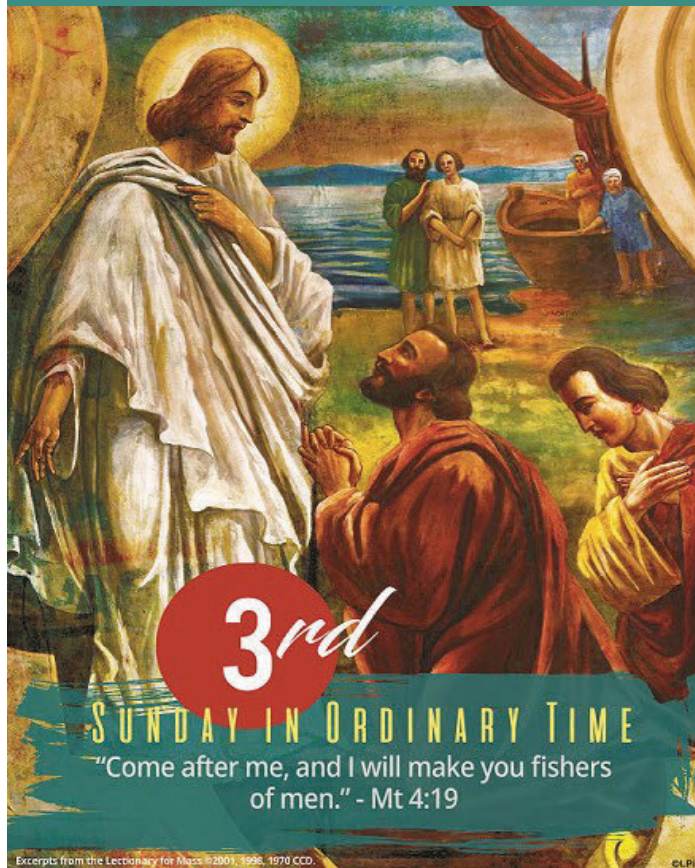
SACRAMENTAL LIFE

Review of the 2021-2022 Parish Plan for St. Catherine Labouré Parish

On March 21, 2021 the then current joint Pastoral Council representing both St. Louise de Marillac and St. Joan of Arc voted to adopt a Parish Plan for the calendar years ending 2021 to 2022. This plan called for establishing a new Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) as set forth in *One Body One Mission: The Parish Pastoral Council Guidelines of the Diocese of Pittsburgh issued by Bishop Zubik on June 6, 2010*. In accordance with the 2021-2022 Parish Plan, the following was enacted and achieved:

- * Assessed the parish's Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities & Threats (SWOT)
- * Identified four major parish-wide Strategic Initiatives for 2021 to address the SWOT findings
- * In the Fall of 2021, three Ad-Hoc Commissions (Family First, Hospitality and Discipleship & Evangelization) met to address the SWOTs
- * These Ad- Hoc Commissions developed a list of over 60 ideas with which to move forward
- * In January 2022, invited all parishioners to discern participation on the newly established PPC
- * In March 2022, 12 parishioners were selected to serve on the new PPC
- * In summer of 2022, solicited 58 additional parishioners to serve on 6 PPC Committees

- * In September 2022, the PPC officially commenced its Council and Committee meetings
- * Since September 2022, the PPC has considered and approved 22 separate proposals

Establishing a New Parish Plan for 2024-2025

This January, an Ad Hoc Planning Committee consisting of members of PPC, the Finance Council and staff have commenced a six-month planning process to establish a comprehensive 2024-2025 Parish Plan for all aspects of parish life (the Mission) and coordinate these plans with our Finance Council to provide the funding there of (the Means for Mission). The purpose of the Plan will be to guide our parish on our journey together in Mission to **Learn Jesus, Love Jesus and Live Jesus and to invite others to share in the sacramental life of our Catholic faith**. What happen to 2023 you might ask? Well, we have decided to coordinate our planning process to match our fiscal year (which begins on July 1 of one year and goes to June 30 of the following year). The interim six-month process (Jan – June 30, 2023) allows us the time to **plan the Plan**. Doing this will allow us to get a fairly accurate projection of expenses and identify the necessary sources of funding for the majority of the 2-year plan period. Other items will be handled on an exception basis. This planning process enables us to move forward with a comprehensive and unified vision.

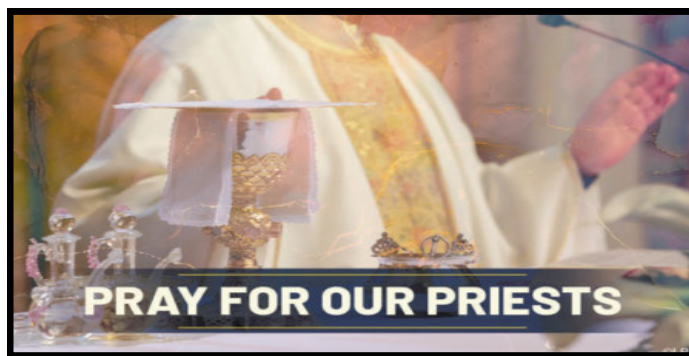

Seasonal Affective Disorder

Seasonal affective disorder (SAD) is a type of depression that's related to changes in seasons, typically associated with shorter days. It usually begins and ends at around the same time each year, usually beginning in the fall/winter and resolving in the spring/summer. Symptoms include feeling of sadness, changes in appetite, low energy, social withdrawal, hypersomnia (oversleeping), feelings of hopelessness and difficulty concentrating. Treatment for SAD may include light therapy (phototherapy), exercise, psychotherapy, and medications.



Most of us suffer from periods of feeling down, but if this persists for days at a time and interferes with normal activities, see your doctor. This is especially important if your sleep patterns and appetite have changed, you turn to alcohol for comfort, or you feel hopeless or think about suicide (SUICIDE HOTLINE 988).

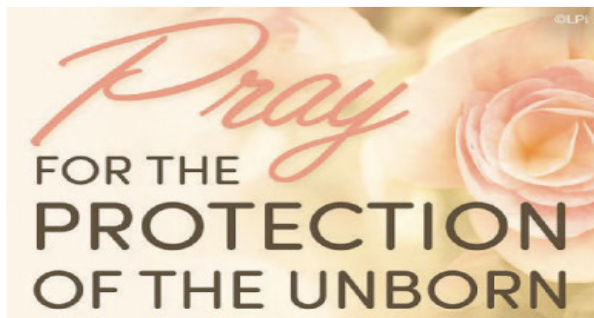

Disciple Maker Index

Over the past month we have updated the Saint Catherine Labouré parish family on the Diocese of Pittsburgh partnership with Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI) to provide parishes with the tools and resources needed to create pastoral plans focused on Evangelization, Hospitality, and Mission. On Ash Wednesday, February 22, a 75-question survey instrument, the Disciple Maker Index (DMI), will be made available to all Saint Catherine Labouré parishioners via the internet or paper copy, allowing parishioners the opportunity to reflect

upon (1.) individual spiritual growth and (2.) engagement with our parish. Bishop Zubik has asked all parishes in the Diocese of Pittsburgh to participate. Results from our parish survey will be available in the April/May 2023 timeframe. All responses will be confidential. Saint Catherine Labouré will only receive information about our parish community as a whole. The information gathered from the DMI will be a valuable planning tool for our parish as we develop goals and action items to help us grow in discipleship as we lead others back to the church. Between now and Ash Wednesday we will continue to update you on this important initiative. We hope you will plan on participating.

FOLLOWING JESUS



Jesus started his earthly ministry by pouring into twelve men. That original small group went on to evangelize the whole world. Our faith is nurtured and deepened in small community.

A small group consists of 6-12 people who commit to meeting regularly with the specific purpose of growing in their faith together. Every small group incorporates Scripture, prayer, and service, but each group develops its own flavor based on how they balance those three aspects.

A small group can look like a formal weekly Bible study. But it could also be a group of moms who meet at a park and pray together while the kids play. Or the Prayer Shawl ministry where the members have fellowship while knitting together and praying for the recipients of their handiwork.

Many groups are official ministries of the parish, such as Alpha, where members are assigned to the group and get to know each other over time. Other groups are more informal, where people who already know each other decide to start meeting regularly for Scripture study or prayer.

The hallmarks of a small group are the commitment of the members to meeting regularly, learning more about their faith, and growing together in love of God and love of neighbor. It is the goal of the Small Group Initiative here at Saint Catherine Labouré to connect every parishioner to the small group that is right for them.

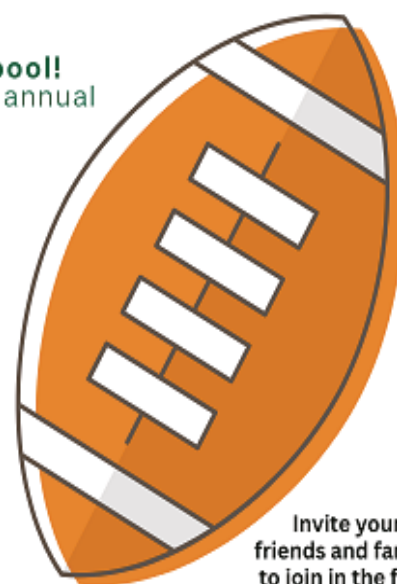

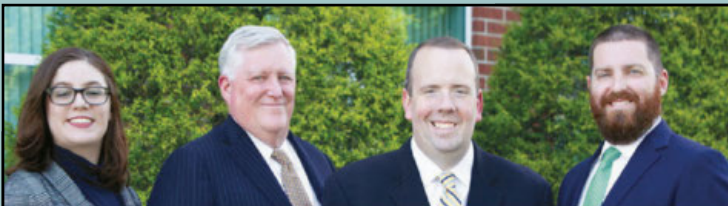
