
SACRAMENTAL LIFE



PARISH NURSE MINISTRY

Lyme Disease

Outsmart Lyme Disease with awareness of the presence of ticks in **grassy, brushy and wooded areas**. A tick bite looks somewhat like a mosquito bite.

Outsmart ticks: usually they attach themselves to your lower legs. Use tick repellent spray, wear light colored clothing, avoid sandals/open toes shoes, tuck shirts into your pants and pants into your socks. Ticks can be extremely small -some the size of a pinhead.

Check for ticks on your skin and clothing after walking in any of the **aforementioned areas**. Should you notice any suspicious rashes, see your health care provider to rule out Lyme Disease. If you're immunocompromised, this is critically important.



PHASES OF LYME DISEASE

Stage 1

Symptoms of early localized Lyme disease begin days or weeks after infection. They are similar to the flu and may include:

**Body-Wide Itching • Chills • Fever • General Ill-Feeling • Headache
Light-Headedness • Fainting • Muscle Pain • Stiff Neck**

Stage 2

Symptoms of early disseminated Lyme disease may occur weeks to months after the initial tick bite. They may include:

**• Paralysis or weakness in the muscles of the face
• Muscle pain and pain or swelling in the knees and other large joints
• Heart problems, such as skipped heartbeats (palpitations)**

Stage 3

Symptoms of late disseminated Lyme disease can occur months or years after the initial infection. The most common symptoms are muscle and joint pain. Other symptoms may include:

**Abnormal Muscle Movement • Muscle Weakness • Numbness and Tingling
Speech problems**


