
SACRAMENTAL LIFE



Lvme Disease

Outsmart Lyme Disease with awareness of the presence of ticks in grassy, brushy and wooded areas. A tick bite looks somewhat like a mosquito bite.



Outsmart ticks: usually they attach themselves to your lower legs. Use tick repellent spray, wear light colored clothing, avoid sandals/open toes shoes, tuck shirts into your pants and pants into your socks. Ticks can be extremely small -some the size of a pinhead.

Check for ticks on your skin and clothing after walking in any of the aforementioned areas. Should you notice any suspicious rashes, see your health care provider to rule out Lyme Disease. If you're immunocompromised, this is critically important.

PHASES OF LYME DISEASE

Symptoms of early localized Lyme disease begin days or weeks after infection. They are similar to the flu and may include:

Body-Wide Itching . Chills . Fever . General III-Feeling . Headache Light-Headedness • Fainting • Muscle Pain • Stiff Neck

Symptoms of early disseminated Lyme disease may occur weeks to months after the initial tick bite. They may include:

- Paralysis or weakness in the muscles of the face
- Muscle pain and pain or swelling in the knees and other large joints
 Heart problems, such as skipped heartbeats (palpitations)

Stage 3

Symptoms of late disseminated Lyme disease can occur months or years after the initial infection. The most common symptoms are muscle and joint pain. Other symptoms may include:

Abnormal Muscle Movement . Muscle Weakness . Numbness and Tingling Speech problems


