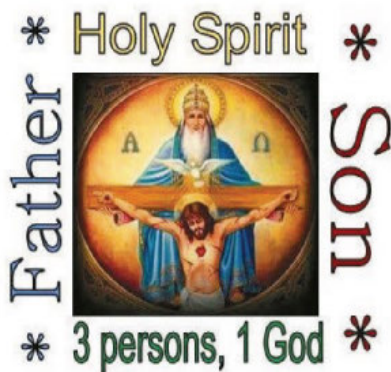

From Fr. Dan...



Today, as we celebrate Trinity Sunday, we call to mind what the Catechism refers to as “the central mystery of our faith”: that God is 3 persons in 1 God. Although it is a difficult concept to get our minds around, what it reveals about God is very powerful — it shows us that in the very essence of God is a loving communion of persons! We are enfolded into that loving communion through the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism makes us adopted children of God and enables us to call God our Father; Eucharist unites us with Jesus Christ, the 2nd person of the Trinity, by sharing His Body and Blood; and Confirmation gives us the fullness of the Holy Spirit. It may be a good point of our prayer and reflection today, to examine if that love that is

God, and that we share sacramentally, spills over into our daily lives and relationships. Do other people experience a loving communion (i.e. the presence of God) when they interact with us?



Next Week, the Catholic Church throughout the world celebrates the Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus (a.k.a. Corpus Christi). AND, we are also in the midst of a three year Eucharistic Revival effort throughout the dioceses of the United States. To celebrate this, and given that our neighboring parish IS Corpus Christi Parish (in the Bridgeville area) we are co-hosting with them a special celebration of this feast day. Be sure to see the full-page advertisement in today's bulletin for all the details. Hopefully, you are able to participate in this wonderful event, organized by the Nature of Fire evangelization team!

July will see some changes in both staff and clergy in our parish community. Sister M. Faith Balawejder, CSSF, will be retiring from parish ministry and discerning new roles and involvement within her Felician community; I will be moving to a different parish (*St. Raphael the Archangel Parish — Green Tree, Scott Township, and Carnegie*) and taking on a different role (that of “Senior Parochial Vicar”); AND Fr. Joseph Sioli will also be moving to a different Parish (*Regina Coeli Parish — Bellevue, Franklin Park, and Emsworth*) and also taking on the new role of “Senior Parochial Vicar.” I became the administrator of then St. Louise de Marillac Parish and St. Joan of Arc Parish in July of 2020, and then (when the two parishes officially merged) the pastor of St. Catherine Labouré Parish in January of 2021. However, that was all in the midst of the Covid pandemic. There was not an opportunity, at that time, to celebrate Fr. Joe's many years of service to this parish community. Even after I became pastor, Fr. Joe continued to reside here in our parish and regularly helped out with Masses and Confessions. Therefore, along with Sr. Faith and I, Fr. Joe will be part of our Farewell gathering in LeGras Hall, following the noon Mass on June 18.

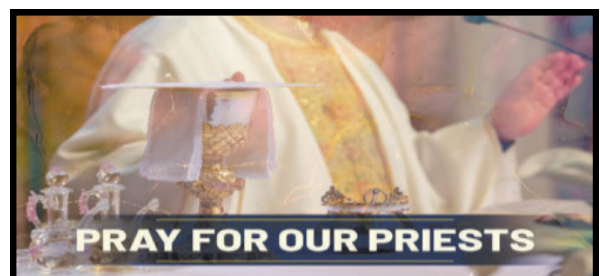

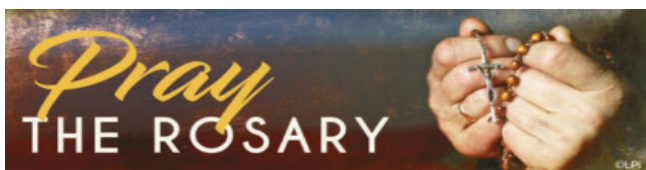

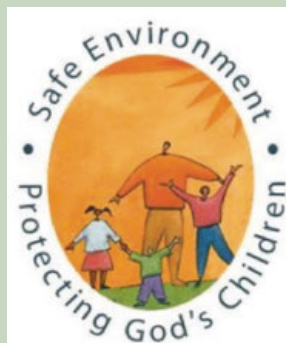

Obtaining Clearances for Employees and Volunteers (Parish & School)

In order to be eligible to volunteer or work in the parish or school it is mandatory that you complete the Diocesan Safe Environment Process prior to employment or participating in any parish activity.

If you have been contacted to renew your clearances please respond as soon as possible.

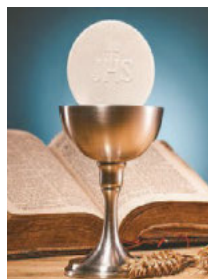

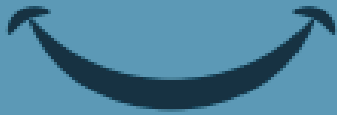

This summer, the Appalachia Work Camp will be building two homes, 2 additions and 4 decks. It was a difficult trip to Kentucky this April. Our contractors had to choose between several families desperately in need of a home. They met with Jessica Baker who had lost their home to flooding in Brethitt County last year. Jessica is now living in a shed and small trailer on the family's lot where her home once stood with her mom, two siblings and disabled uncle. Unfortunately, because her lot is in the flood plain, the state currently will not allow new construction on their property. They will, for now, have to continue living in their shed, or as Jessica called it, their cabin.

The next stop was Jennifer and Rodney's property. During the flood and torrential rains, the wall of water coming off of the back hillside washed under their trailer and washed the front deck off the trailer and down into the creek. The trailer had a lot of water damage inside and out. Jessica was home alone and thought that she was going to be washed over the hillside in the trailer. She was terrified. Unfortunately, we are not able to build them a home on their lot as it is too small and dangerously close to the road.

Our next stop was to meet JD & Christine. Their trailer was completely washed away in last year's flooding. JD's son's trailer on the hill behind them was not damaged but had to be moved as the property was heavily damaged and washed away. An aunt gave them a piece of her property and we will build JD & Christine a home on that property next to his son's newly located trailer.

We then headed to Owsley County to meet with Christopher & Jessica and their two month old baby Lilly, named after Jessica's mom who passed away last year. They have been living in Christopher's late grandfather's home for several years now. Their current home is wooden, dilapidated, unsafe and has no water or sewage. Christopher has spent many weeks clearing his property and making space for a possible new home. We were excited to tell them that we would be back in July to build them a new home....one with running water, a septic system, and a bathroom.



We will also build an addition for Krystal and Ray, a bedroom for their daughter Kaylie. Their trailer is very small and they asked if we could build an addition to give them more room.

The last visit was to meet Elizabeth Dulley. She had some major water damage to her trailer and we will make some changes to the roof and do repairs for her.

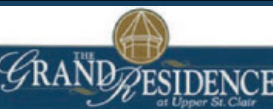
