
SACRAMENTAL LIFE



From Fr. Dan...

Today, the universal Church celebrates **THE FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST** (formerly known more simply as "Corpus Christi"). This has special significance at this time in the United States, as dioceses across the country are beginning the second year of a three-year NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL.



The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch." (CCC 1324)

Despite that fact, though, there are many, even some among otherwise faithful Catholics, who do not believe (or more accurately, <u>understand</u>) the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, and therefore fail to share in it regularly and fail to benefit from the grace it offers. Eucharistic Revival efforts can and hopefully will heighten the appreciation of all Catholics regarding this greatest of spiritual gifts and possibly even awaken in those outside of our Catholic Faith a sense of Christ's enduring presence among us in the Eucharist. Our world desperately needs that presence!

We have many opportunities in our own parish (and neighboring parishes) to celebrate Christ's presence in the Eucharist, and to benefit spiritually from spending time in that presence:

- * This afternoon our neighboring parish, sharing its name with today's feast, "Corpus Christi Parish," located in Bridgeville, is hosting a Eucharistic Procession. This has become a tradition for that parish and we are joining with them this year as a joint parish evangelization event coordinated by our evangelization team, "Nature of Fire." Following the Noon Mass at their St. Barbara Church, several hundred people will process with the Eucharist through the streets of Bridgeville (under a police escort that closes off the streets), to another of their churches, Holy Child. The procession concludes at Holy Child Church with a witness-talk on the power of the Eucharist, some praise and worship, and the Rite of Benediction. This will be followed by a picnic celebration with free food and fun. (See the full page flyer later in this bulletin.) Everyone is invited and encouraged to join in this procession. You don't have to attend the Mass there to be a part of this. Even if you participated at a different Mass, you can just show up a little before 1:00 PM and join in the procession.
- * Every Tuesday, we have a day-long period of **Eucharistic Adoration** at St. Louise Church, typically beginning after the 9 AM Mass and continuing throughout the day, concluding with a special prayer service and benediction at 7:30 PM. All are invited and encouraged to stop in anytime during that period for personal prayer before our Eucharistic Lord. Holy Child Church of Corpus Christi Parish has a similar period of adoration on Wednesdays from 12:30pm to 8pm. Plus, another neighboring parish, Resurrection Parish, at its St. Thomas More Church, has a special adoration chapel, the "Lamb of God Chapel" where there is Eucharistic Adoration 24/6 (it only ceases during Sunday Masses). See their website, www.resurrectionpgh.org, for more details.
- * St. Catherine Labouré Parish is one of only a few parishes in our Diocese to have a **Nocturnal Adoration Society**, which consists of groups of people who pray before the Eucharist on the <u>first Friday</u> of each month, from 10 PM Friday to 8 AM Saturday. Different groups take one-hour time slots throughout the night. Those who are part of the Society are always glad to welcome new "Adorers" and introduce them to the prayers and worship of this special monthly vigil.

These special adoration opportunities are all in addition to the 15 daily Masses we have spread throughout the week and our 8 Sunday Masses (over Saturday evening and Sunday). Since participation in the Mass is the most common manner in which we encounter our Eucharistic Lord, following are just some thoughts on how we approach the Eucharist:

- * Our Communion is a union with Christ <u>and</u> a union in faith with His Church. Therefore, if we wish to receive Communion in the Catholic Church, we should be *striving* to live according to the faith of the Church. If we choose to ignore certain aspects of the teaching of Christ, as they have been passed on to us through the Church, then we are not "in communion" with the Body of Christ and, thus, receiving the Eucharist professes something through our external actions that we have chosen not to embrace internally.
- * On the other hand, if through our human weakness we fail to live fully the way of life that Christ calls us to weakening (in the case of venial sin) or severing (in the case of mortal sin) our union with His Body, the Church we should make use of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. To share in His Body and Blood, we should strive to cleanse our lives of whatever is not Christ-like and prepare the temples of our bodies as best we can to receive such an awesome guest.
- * We are also to prepare for receiving our Lord by fasting for one hour. Although an hour without food or drink (except water, medicine, or things necessary for our health) is not much of a sacrifice for any of us, it does serve to remind us that the Body of Christ IS true food and His Blood IS true drink (cf. John 6:55) and we should hunger for them far more then we hunger for the inferior food and drink we regularly indulge in.
- * When one comes forward for Communion, as a unified sign of reverence, one should make a bow of the head before receiving the host. (If one comes forward but is not receiving Communion, they should cross their hands on their chest to receive a blessing from the priest or deacon, or a reminder of Christ's love by the minister.)
- * When the host is presented and the minister says "The Body of Christ" one should respond with an audible "AMEN" this is our affirmation that we truly believe this.

The Eucharistic Liturgy (the Mass) is the highest form of communal prayer that we have as a Church and sharing in the Eucharist is Christ's greatest gift to us to unite us with Himself and each other. Hopefully, we value that gift, and always approach it with reverence and joy!



PARISH NURSE MINISTRY Water Safety

- Secure pools or hot tubs from accidental entry. Check your municipality for specific requirements.
- A responsible, undistracted adult should ALWAYS be within arm's length of children. Drowning is the leading cause of injury related death among 1-to-4-year-olds. It can occur within two minutes.
- Don't push or dunk friends, dive into shallow water, float where you can't swim and pay attention to weather.
- Never jump into unclear water. Be aware of currents, rip tide warnings, high surf advisories, water temperatures and areas marked for alligators/sharks.
- If you can't swim, wear a Coast Guard approved life vest. Noodles, water wings and inner tubes don't count here.


