
#### SACRAMENTAL LIFE






#### **PARISH NURSE MINISTRY**

#### **Firework Safety**

The National Safety Council advises *not to use any fireworks at home*. Last year alone there were over 12,000 injuries and nine deaths related to home use. If you choose to use legal fireworks, be sure to follow the following safety tips:

- \* Never allow children to handle fireworks.
- \* Fireworks and alcohol do not mix.
- \* Wear protective eyewear.
- \* Never hold lighted fireworks in your hands.
- \* Never light them indoors.
- \* Only use them away from people, houses, and flammable material.
- \* Never ignite devices in a container.
- \* Do not try to re-light or handle malfunctioning fireworks.
- \* Keep a bucket of water nearby to fully extinguish.
- \* Sparkler wires and sticks remain hot long after the flame has gone out.
- \* Have a bucket of water nearby and soak fireworks in water for a few hours before discarding, even if unused.




