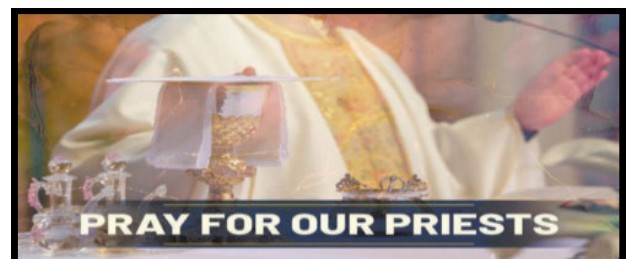

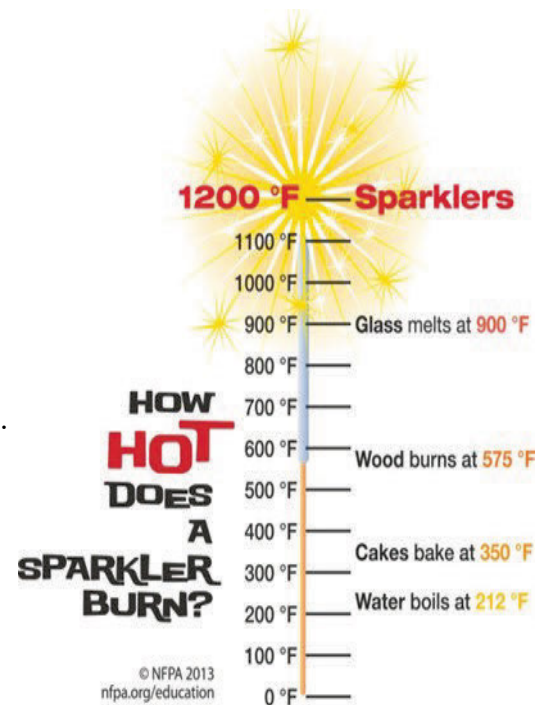


PARISH NURSE MINISTRY

Firework Safety

The National Safety Council advises *not to use any fireworks at home*. Last year alone there were over 12,000 injuries and nine deaths related to home use. If you choose to use legal fireworks, be sure to follow the following safety tips:

- * Never allow children to handle fireworks.
- * Fireworks and alcohol do not mix.
- * Wear protective eyewear.
- * Never hold lighted fireworks in your hands.
- * Never light them indoors.
- * Only use them away from people, houses, and flammable material.
- * Never ignite devices in a container.
- * Do not try to re-light or handle malfunctioning fireworks.
- * Keep a bucket of water nearby to fully extinguish.
- * Sparkler wires and sticks remain hot long after the flame has gone out.
- * Have a bucket of water nearby and soak fireworks in water for a few hours before discarding, even if unused.

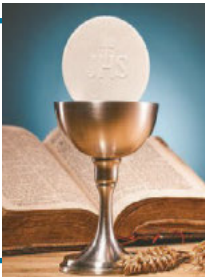

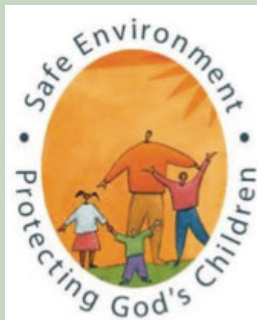

Obtaining Clearances for Employees and Volunteers (Parish & School)

Go to <https://diopitt.org/compliance> and follow the appropriate steps if you are a new user or if you already have an existing account.



In order to be eligible to volunteer or work in the parish or school it is mandatory that you complete the Diocesan Safe Environment Process prior to employment or participating in any parish activity.

If you have been contacted to renew your clearances please respond as soon as possible.
