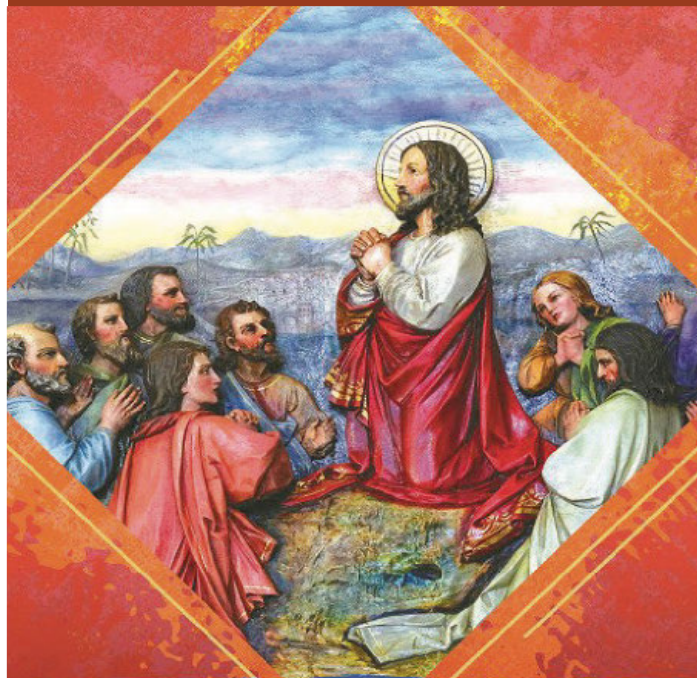

From Fr. Dan...

Well, this is my last “From Fr. Dan” column in this bulletin. Starting this coming Monday, July 10, I will no longer be the Pastor of St. Catherine Labouré Parish, but will become the new Senior Parochial Vicar at St. Raphael the Archangel Parish. (That is the new name for the combined parishes of Sts. Simon and Jude, in Scott Township; St. Margaret of Scotland, in Greentree; and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, in Carnegie.) On that same day, Fr. Jeff Craig will become the new Pastor of St. Catherine Labouré Parish.

My past years as Pastor of this parish have been quite an experience. The Covid-19 pandemic colored much of my time in this role and presented many challenges, as it did for everyone. Officially joining the two former parishes of St. Joan of Arc and St. Louise de Marillac into the new St Catherine Labouré Parish, was for the most part smooth (thanks to the groundwork done by my predecessor, Fr. Joe Sioli, and the diligent work of a great parish staff) — but still required a lot of thought, planning and “behind the scenes” activity. Similar to the parishes, all the Catholic elementary schools of our Diocese have also been grouped into various local/regional catholic school systems. And while it makes good sense fiscally and also as a means to insure consistent quality education across all of our Diocesan Catholic Schools, the “regionalization process” necessitated the reconfiguring of how things were handled on many different levels.

In addition to those things that each caused changes, there have been in recent years political and social issues that have created upheaval. ALL of these things have left many people with a heightened sense of uncertainty and anxiety, some of them even provoking a sense of frustration or anger. However, for people of Faith, such events and situations can and should draw us to a greater appreciation of our relationship with God! God, and His love and care for us as human beings, is the only constant. Trusting in God is what ultimately gets us through the ups, downs, and changes of this life. And God constantly makes Himself known to us and enables us to experience his presence, through His Church and specifically, through the Sacraments. It has been an honor and a privilege to be able to bring the Sacraments to all of you and, in some way, hopefully, to help you find your way closer to that loving embrace of our Heavenly Father and to rest in His peace. That’s always been my goal as a priest. In fact, it’s the reason I became a priest in the first place, AND the reason I asked for a change in assignment. While I always at least *strive* to do well, and be effective, as a **priest**, I know that in juggling the demands and responsibilities of being a **pastor**, I often fall short. I know I don’t always respond to things promptly and that some things completely “fall through the cracks” — for that I apologize. I also realize that not every decision I’ve made has been seen as positive by everyone. Nor has everything I’ve addressed or chosen not to address, been agreeable with everyone. BUT, as I look back, I honestly believe that God has been doing the REAL behind the scenes work and has been wonderfully active in this faith community. God has blessed this parish with good clergy in the past and present — both in Fr. Jon Brzek, who will be continuing to minister in this parish; and in Fr. Jeff Craig, about to take over as pastor — as well as in the many good priests, Benedictine and Diocesan, that help out here. God has blessed this parish with a great staff of dedicated, talented people — to whom I am deeply grateful for all the help they’ve provided me over these past years! God has inspired many wonderful, caring people to step forward as volunteers and share in all the many areas of ministry in this parish. And this parish is blessed with SO MANY people who, aware of the good things that God has given them, are always ready to generously share that goodness with others and the larger parish community. We’re also blessed that, as we emerged from Covid and began to function as one new parish, a dynamic Parish Pastoral Council took shape and has had a significant positive impact on the vitality of this faith community. Yes, there are MANY blessings in St. Catherine Labouré Parish, and I’m grateful that I was able to be a part of it. Now, as time moves on, there will be new opportunities, new activities/ministries, new endeavors — and certainly, new challenges! But through it all, God will always provide guidance to those who are open to it. And God will continue to ultimately shepherd this community.

I will keep the people of this parish in my prayers and I hope that you might likewise keep me in your prayers — and pray for your new pastor, Fr. Jeff. God bless you ALL!

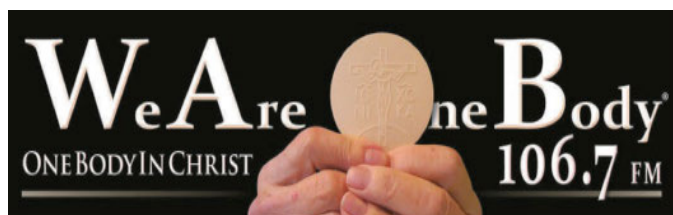
NOCTURNAL ADORATION

UV Protection

Skin cancer is the **most common** form of cancer. According to the Skin Cancer Foundation report 1 in 5 Americans will develop skin cancer in their lifetime and by having just five sunburns, your risk is doubled!



Protect yourself from UV and UVB rays:

- Block UV light with protective clothing, hats and sunglasses.
- Stay in the shade, especially during the hours of 10am and 4pm.
- Skin damage can still occur on cloudy days, in winter and at higher elevations.
- Choose a sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher, is water resistant, and use year-round.
- Stay away from sources of artificial UV light.

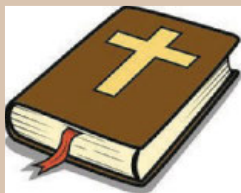

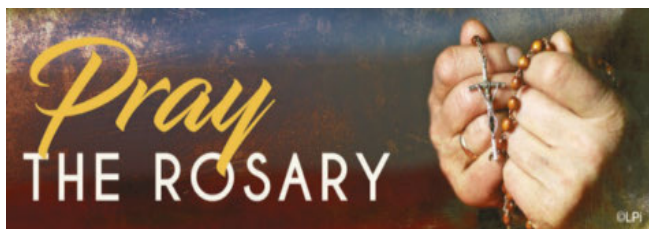

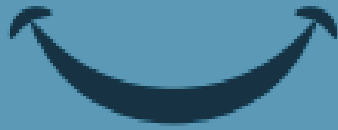
