
SACRAMENTAL LIFE

Homily and Appeal for the 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A By Bishop Martin of the Diocese of Karonga Malawi, Africa

Weeds alongside wheat

The gospel text of today speaks about weeds that grow alongside the wheat. Even when the good seed is planted by the good sower, the realities of earthly existence allow the weeds also to be planted and to grow and thrive alongside the wheat. The weeds can choke the wheat and stop its growth. The wheat can also grow to its maturity within the weeds; waiting for the promised harvest.

We who are the children of God are the wheat. At the same time, our shortfalls, our pride, selfishness, greed, as well as the many forces and agents of the Evil One in our world and communities are the weeds. As we live and grow in the grace of God, that growth promised to us at our baptism, we are constantly thwarted, held back, bent over and sometimes chocked, by the weeds of the time.

But in the gospel text, Jesus assures us that the promises of God are sure. Jesus echoes the word from God to the prophets that we need not fear; God's care is for us certain. The weeds cannot stop us. We are called to grow into the grace of eternity. And so we stretch always to the sunshine, lifting our heads to God's promised growth. With full trust in the promised harvest of eternity, we live in this weed-choked world, confident in our growth in God's unchanging grace.

Rather than being discouraged or overcome by all the weeds around and within us we ask for the grace of:

Distinguishing right from wrong like the one given to Solomon.

Seeing the worthiness of sacrificing everything to possess and experience the Kingdom's blessings.

Seeing the importance of making choices that align with God's righteousness and the consequences of rejecting the Kingdom.

May the Blessed Virgin Mary intercede for us that we may be totally open to the word of God at all times.

Appeal:

Regarding the second collection I very humbly appeal to each one of you to contribute generously. As a Diocese we have three priority areas for its use. And they are:

Children village: We keep close to 200 abandoned and orphaned children who have nobody to look after them in any way. These very vulnerable children depend on Karonga Diocese for everything: food, shelter, clothing, education and the rest.

Fees for seminarians: We have been blessed with 28 major seminarians for which we are very grateful. Unfortunately, we cannot manage to keep all them in the Seminary for the coming formation year. We need \$41,000 to keep them in the seminary for the 2023-2024 formation year. The said amount is too big for us to raise locally. If we don't get any extra help we will have to send away some of the seminarians or ask them to wait at home for a couple of years.

Catechism Lessons for Children: We have 32,000 children between the age of 6 and 14 across the Diocese who need catechetical lessons to prepare for baptism, first communion and confirmation. There is urgent need for teaching materials and training catechists who will give lessons to the children. This is a very essential ministry in very way.

In view of all the three key needs highlighted above I kindly appeal to you help us. And I thank you in advance for your generosity. Not to remain in the position of depending on outside help forever, we have started a coffee and macadamia farm (Chipunga Farms Ltd.) which we would like to manage on a commercial basis. The assistance we need from here is technical assistance and establishing links with potential markets here in the USA. Once again, may the Blessed Virgin Mary intercede for us that we may be totally open to the word of God at all times. **Amen.**



PARISH NURSE MINISTRY

Vitamins and Supplements—Are they Needed?

Television and social media push these products for just about everything! The ads sound enticing but often these are high priced, excellently marketed products promoting unnecessary supplements. When considering supplementing, be aware- not everyone requires or benefits from them.



A well-balanced diet including fruits, vegetables, protein (meat-fish-legumes) for at least one meal daily generally provides adequate amounts. However, vegetarian diets, consuming less

than 1200 calories daily, a medical or intestinal disorder or an alcohol disorder may require the addition of supplemental vitamins. Your body may be unable to metabolize the nutrients you're consuming.

More is not better as it is possible to take too high of a dose and cause complications. If one is only taking a multivitamin daily the chance of over doing it is minimal. Determine first if you are deficient in vitamins or minerals. Then proceed to correct the deficiency.





PASTORAL PLANNING—ENVISIONING TEAM AND PURPOSE



An essential step before beginning a pastoral plan is to establish a parish Envisioning Team consisting of five to seven members. This team will assist Father Jeff with analyzing the results of the Disciple Maker Index Survey and in the creation of a pastoral plan. A pastoral plan lays the path for how best the parish is going to achieve its mission and lead parishioners in furthering our call to Jesus and our ability to lead others to Jesus.

The Church teaches that the purpose of the parish is to proclaim the Gospel, celebrate the Sacraments, and promote works of charity all directed towards the salvation of souls. The process of pastoral planning will allow us to bring this purpose to life as we strive to live out the mission entrusted to the Church by Christ: "Go into the whole world and proclaim the Good News to all of creation". (Mark 16:15).

Please note: the parish will be using the Virtual Track (not Self Directed as previously stated) receiving four individualized virtual tutorials from Catholic Leadership Institute that assist parishes with understanding the DMI results and creating a pastoral plan with priorities and goals. In this track, parishes will be responsible for creating their own implementation strategies.

As a reminder, in order to give ample time for all parishes to prepare for the distribution of DMI results and to ensure that all parishes are receiving information in a consistent manner, a universal distribution date for DMI results has been established for the weekend of August 19/20, 2023. All parishes in the diocese will use a common template to publish their individual results. The weekend of August 26/27, 2023 aggregate results for the entire diocese will be published in parish bulletins.


