

PARISH NURSE MINISTRY

Food Safety

Foodborne illness is common, costly—and preventable. The CDC recommends these four steps in preventing food contamination in your kitchen. Clean your counter, cutting boards, and knives before exposing them to different food items. Separate raw meat, poultry, seafood, and their juices when grocery shopping, storing in the refrigerator and when preparing. Raw chicken does not need to be washed before preparing. This can cause contamination of your other foods, sink, and counter tops. Cook meats and poultry to the recommended internal



temperature. Chill your food promptly. The refrigerator temperature should be kept at 40 degrees F or below and the freezer at 0 degrees F. Thaw food in the refrigerator and not on the counter.



In the Order of Christian Funerals, we read: When a member of Christ's body dies, the faithful are called to a






