I cannot thank everyone enough for all of the efforts that were put together to make my Installation Mass as Pastor last week go so flawlessly! Everything from the liturgical preparations, the music, and the reception was amazing. It was estimated that over 800 people attended the Mass. I was honored that 15 of my brother priests concelebrated the Mass with me and Bishop Zubik. We had many visitors to our parish. I heard from so many of them that we have a beautiful parish, how welcomed they felt, and what a vibrant celebration of the Mass we celebrate. We continued to make upgrades at both of our campuses last week. You'll notice that at St. Joan of Arc, the church grounds were worked on to include new mulch and that trees and bushes received a much-needed trimming. In addition, we had two trees in front of the church removed. This was done because the roots of these trees were impacting the sewer lines and causing issues. It also gave more visibility to our sign in the front of the church.

Over the past several weeks, on the grounds of St. Louise de Marillac church, we replaced many areas of our sidewalks with new concrete in front of the church and the school. Still to come will be the installation of our new security camera system at both campuses.

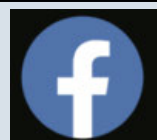

PARISH NURSE MINISRY

Food Allergies

In 1999, 3.4 percent of kids had a food allergy, and we are now seeing over 5.7 percent of kids with a food allergy. The leading theory on why this is happening is the hygiene hypothesis. Environmental factors such as overuse of hygiene products and antibiotics, increase in processed foods, and a reduction in the consumptions of whole foods (fruits, veggies, whole grains) are leading to changes in the composition of the gut microbiome (normal microorganisms that live in the GI tract). In addition, harsh detergents and environmental chemicals are prevalent. Protect yourself and your kids by choosing fresh, whole foods, and taking antibiotics only when needed. Choose plant-based household, skin care and hygiene products. Choose hand washing over chemical hand sanitizers whenever possible.



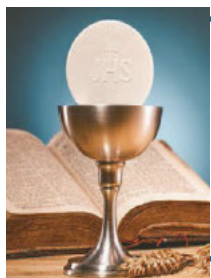
