
SACRAMENTAL LIFE

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER JEFF

Many exciting things continue to take place!

As you all know, Tracey Buckley has been working for both the parish and the school as the Director of Advancement. After having listened to many of you of the need to focus on our communication strategy as a parish, I have hired Tracey as the Director of Communications and Advancement for St. Catherine Labouré Parish. With this addition to our parish staff, we will:

- build out our parish brand,
- revamp our parish website,
- have a more consistent and informative presence on our social media platforms,
- increase promotions of upcoming parish events and offerings,
- implement a communication strategy that reaches out to those in our community in a way that our current communication methods do not.
- continually reevaluate the most effective ways to convey all of the offerings of St. Catherine Labouré Parish in a (seemingly) constantly changing world of communication!

Tracey begins this new position September 1st. In the meantime, she has generously offered to be of support for the next Director of Advancement at St. Louise de Marillac School in order to help make for a smooth and seamless transition.

Last week I received a call from St. Vincent Seminary in Latrobe, PA. They've gotten word that amazing things are happening here at St. Catherine Labouré Parish! Because of this, they would like one of their seminarians from the Diocese of Brooklyn, New York to experience what parish life is like here for the upcoming academic year. Therefore, beginning in the first half of September, we will have a Transitional Deacon assigned to us while he is still taking classes at St. Vincent Seminary during the week. He will be with us during each weekend to help assist at Masses, baptisms, Sunday Faith Formation Classes, and Youth Group gatherings, among other things. As a Transitional Deacon, he is in his last year of seminary training before being ordained a Priest. This will not only be a formative experience for him to be in such an active parish, but it will also be an opportunity for our parish to help cultivate an environment that supports vocations to the priesthood and religious life. I will have more information about him in a future bulletin article.

PPC Update:

Since joining the parish I have attended three Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) meetings and have met with a number of the council members individually. They are doing very good work for our parish. The PPC is made up of twelve members. At the current time we only have eleven members, so a vacancy exists. 



PARISH NURSE MINISTRY

Social Media and Children and Adolescents

Innocent beginnings morph into potential nightmares. Children experiencing sleeplessness resulting in poor school performance, bullying, emotional distress and sometimes suicide. Be aware that children/adolescents have limited capacities for self-regulation and are susceptible to peer pressure.



The minimum age for most social media sites is thirteen. Parents must evaluate the sites their child wishes to participate in for age appropriateness. Discuss what's ok, what's not and unintended consequences of sharing too much information. Digital footprints are forever. Risks for emotional harm, derailment of future college acceptance or job opportunities can't be overstated.



Monitor usage- both time and content. Behavioral changes are a red flag! Encourage face-to-face interactions and physical activity rather than social media time.



Their duties include:

- 3. Attending the funeral Mass to greet, seat the deceased family members and guide the readers and gift bearers during the funeral Mass.

CHOOSING GODPARENTS

From time to time questions and controversies arise as to who may serve as a Godparent for the Sacrament of Baptism. Therefore, this is a review of the guidelines established by the Catholic Church concerning Godparent eligibility. These regulations should be considered before the parents of a child ask someone to be a Godparent for their son or daughter:

- The decision as to who should be a Godparent should be based upon who would provide the best example of Catholic living for the child and not merely for reasons of maintaining family harmony. A Godparent is chosen not primarily to honor the Godparent, but for the well-being and faith development of the child.
- ♦ In order to be a Godparent for Baptism, an individual must be a practicing Catholic, at least 16 years of age and have received the Sacraments of Initiation (i.e. Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation). 'Furthermore, if this person is married, then the marriage must be a valid, sacramental marriage (i.e. one recognized and blessed by the Catholic Church).
- ♦ The potential Godparent must be registered in a Catholic parish and able to obtain from his or her parish priest a letter of eligibility to be a Godparent.
- Only one Godparent is required by Church law. This Godparent may be a man or a woman. However, if two Godparents are selected (the more common practice), then there must be one man and one woman chosen. In other words, a child cannot have two men or two women as Godparents.
- In extraordinary situations when two Catholic Godparents cannot be found, then a baptized person who belongs to another Christian denomination (e.g. Methodist, Lutheran, or Presbyterian) may serve as a Christian Witness. However, former Catholics who have left the Catholic Church for another Christian denomination are not permitted to serve as Christian Witnesses.

Since Baptism is the initial, foundational Sacrament in the life of a Catholic, great care must be taken in deciding who will serve as a Godparent. The guidelines above are meant to assist parents in making a reasonable and secure decision as to who will fulfill this critical role for their child. Since they are provided by the universal Church and individual priests are not vested with the authority to dispense from them, these guidelines will be strictly followed.
