

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER JEFF

As I mentioned a couple of weeks ago, we are blessed to have a Transitional Deacon from St. Vincent Seminary to be assigned to our parish for his upcoming academic year. Deacon Randy Nguyen is from the Diocese of Brooklyn, NY. He will join us this month and will be a great witness to our parish of the need to continue to pray for and promote vocations to the priesthood as he prepares to be ordained to the priesthood next Summer.

From my first day as your pastor, I saw and felt this parish's dedication to, and the love of the Eucharist, especially at the celebration of Holy Mass. As a Catholic priest it is uplifting and inspiring to me. As we all know, the shortage of priests is real and we, as a diocese and as a parish, are not exempt from this reality. That is why Bishop Zubik embarked on the *On Mission* exercise several years ago to address our shortage of priests. With our parish having had 3 priests in residence up until July, we were able to maintain the daily Mass schedule of 3 Masses per day (with the exception of Friday where we offer 2 Masses.) Now with only Fr. Jon and I at our parish, we will not be able to keep offering 3 daily Masses. We are not alone in this reality. It is a fact that only a handful of parishes in the entire Diocese of Pittsburgh offer 3 daily Masses, and most of those parishes have 4 priests in residence. This is not an easy thing for me to consider.

Currently, our daily Mass attendance average is:
7am STL: 65 people 8am SJA: 15 people 9am STL: 50 people
(9am average not including Friday School Mass or Saturday Morning 9am Mass)

These numbers, along with other nearby parish Mass schedules that have similar daily Mass times, will be among the guiding factors as to what our 2 daily Mass times will be in the near future. Please stay tuned to a future bulletin announcing the new daily Mass schedule and when it will be implemented.

Please note these changes will not impact our weekend Mass schedule which we will continue to offer with the able assistance of the priests from St. Vincent Archabbey.

Please know as your pastor, and while I continue to evaluate all of the necessary decisions that this office entails, I constantly pray and reflect about how to move our parish forward. When it comes to the decision on our daily Mass schedule, I know there will be disappointment. Please know that any decision I make will be made only after considerable prayer, discussion, and internal debate with the clergy team, my staff, and others guided by my heart on what is the best path forward for our parish and our clergy. Please pray for me and know that truly, I always pray in gratitude to God for you.

In celebration of Labor Day, our offices are closed on Monday, September 4th.

WELCOME TO SAINT CATHERINE LABOURÉ





Their duties include:


- 1. Offering condolences and the prayers on behalf of Saint Catherine Labouré Parish Family.






