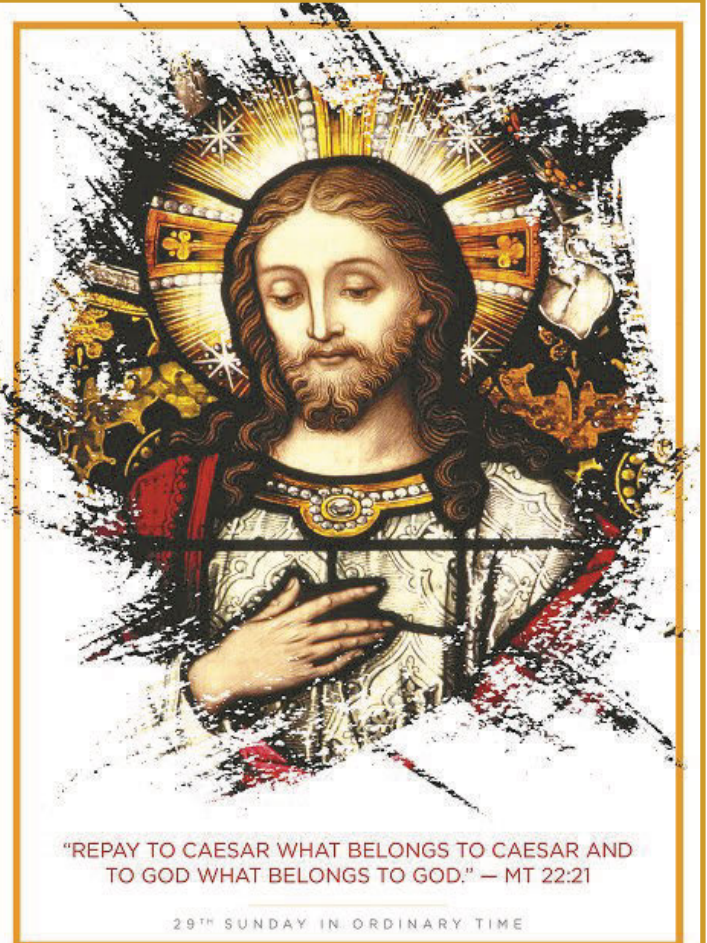

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER JEFF

Time for Reflection and Gratitude

Last week I had the opportunity to go south for vacation with other priest friends of mine. With all of the activity that comes along with receiving a new parish assignment this past summer, I was unable to take any time off. I felt as though this was a much needed time to relax (which for me consists of time on the beach and on the golf course!) Whenever I go on vacation, it is a time to leave behind the busyness of everyday life and to enjoy the simple things. At the same time, it also helps me to grow in appreciation for what my normal everyday life consists of, most especially for me over the last 3 months of being the Pastor here at St. Catherine Labouré Parish.

As I was away and had the chance to reflect on the last 3 months, I truly felt a great sense of gratitude in my heart for all of the graces that God has given me in a very short amount of time. And so, with that realization I wanted to thank all of you for being such a gift to me.

I want to thank those who have invited me over to their family homes for a meal and made me feel like part of the family. I want to thank all of those who have offered their time and resources to the many new initiatives that our parish has started. I want to thank all of those who send me small notes (or emails) of encouragement or gratitude for even the smallest of things. I want to thank all of you for your faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays, even in the midst of a sometimes busy and chaotic schedule. I want to thank those who both volunteer and participate in the many events that we are able to provide as a parish community. I want to thank the parish staff for doing such an amazing job at serving the parish and allowing me to focus much of my time and energy to what I love and need to do the most, which is being a priest out in the community as compared to a priest always behind a desk. I want to thank the clergy team for being so supportive and working so hard to make our parish a community focused on helping all of us see where God is in our particular life and how He draws us to Himself in the Eucharist. It is obvious how good God is to all of us when we take time to reflect.

Sometimes in the busyness and distractions of life, it is so easy to lose sight of all the good that God does in our lives. Likewise, it is not always possible to get away for days to be able to have the opportunity to reflect on this. *At times, we only have a small opportunity here and there to be able to meditate and focus on the good that is around us because of the God who loves us.* This is one of the reasons why I wanted to offer an opportunity for Adoration, Confession, and Mass at various times each week in our parish. Whether it is before the 7pm Mass on Wednesday at St. Louise or before the noon Mass on Thursday at St. Joan's, these are powerful opportunities to take a midweek break from the busyness and chaos of life and to spend a moment with God in His Goodness, in His Presence, and in the Eucharist. And this is the perfect place to offer thanksgiving to God, as we read in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (1359-1361):

"The Eucharist, the sacrament of our salvation accomplished by Christ on the cross, is also a sacrifice of praise in thanksgiving for the work of creation. In the Eucharistic sacrifice the whole of creation loved by God is presented to the Father through the death and the Resurrection of Christ. Through Christ the Church can offer the sacrifice of praise in thanksgiving for all that God has made good, beautiful, and just in creation and in humanity.

The Eucharist is a sacrifice of thanksgiving to the Father, a blessing by which the Church expresses her gratitude to God for all his benefits, for all that he has accomplished through creation, redemption, and sanctification. Eucharist means first of all "thanksgiving."

The Eucharist is also the sacrifice of praise by which the Church sings the glory of God in the name of all creation. This sacrifice of praise is possible only through Christ: he unites the faithful to his person, to his praise, and to his intercession, so that the sacrifice of praise to the Father is offered through Christ and with him, to be accepted in him."

May we always be ready to give thanks to God for the wonderful and unique ways in which He shows us His great love. May we cultivate hearts of gratitude and praise to God for His goodness. Each day, may we thank God for 5 things, 5 new things each day, so we may always be reminded of just how much God truly does love each and every one of us. Please know, I thank God for each of you!

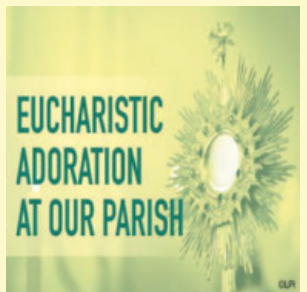
More than prayer. One hour is very little time to give to the one you want to spend eternity with. Please consider signing

Please sign up for our Flocknote Eucharistic Adoration Group to receive the weekly sign up availability and commit to spending some quiet time in adoration of Our Lord.

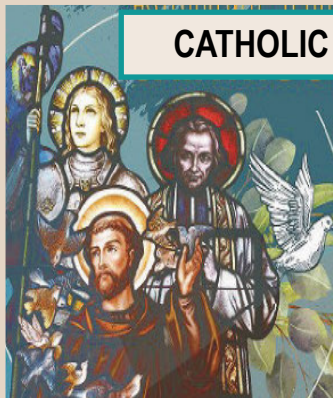

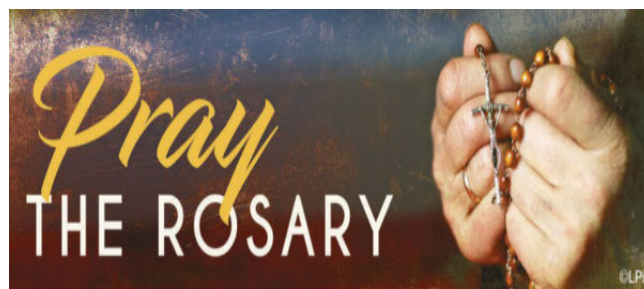

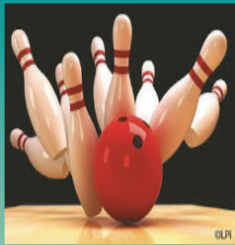

Funeral Liturgy Planners: In the Order of Christian Funerals, we read: When a member of Christ's body dies, the faithful are called to a ministry of consolation to those who have suffered a loss of one they love. They are called to "comfort the mourning." It is within this call to "comfort the mourning" that Saint Catherine Labouré Parish is launching a new ministry, that of **Funeral Liturgy Planner**.

In this role, **Funeral Liturgy Planners** meet and assist families in preparing the Mass of Christian Burial that honors their loved one.

Their duties include:

1. Offering condolences and the prayers on behalf of Saint Catherine Labouré Parish Family.
2. Assisting families fill out the Saint Catherine Labouré Parish Funeral Liturgy Planning Guide and then passing that along to the appropriate staff.
3. Attending the funeral Mass to greet, seat the deceased family members and guide the readers and gift bearers during the funeral Mass.

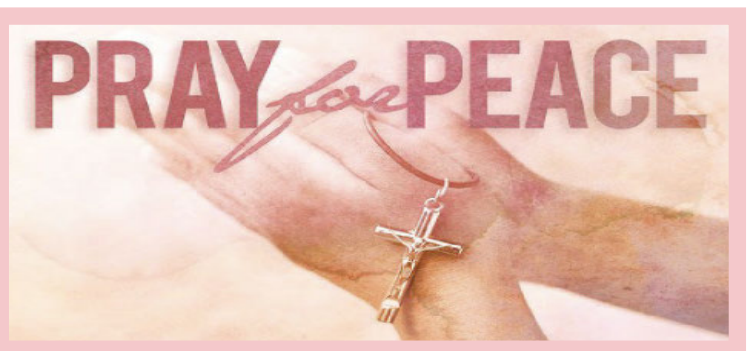

Bullying Prevention Month—Is MY Child a Bully?

No parent wants to believe this! Our incredibly busy lives may cause us to minimize bullying behaviors, chalking it up to merely a passing phase. Parents, teachers, families and friends can no longer assume this. Recognizing that a child might be a perpetrator of bullying demands attention.

The Bully

- Impulsive
- Easily Frustrated
- No personal coping skills
- Lacks empathy
- Difficulty following rules/frequent misbehavior
- Elevated sense of self
- Exposed to more violence at home, television, video games etc.
- Sense of entitlement
- Academic issues
- Attention seeking
- Difficulty problem solving
- Does not accept responsibility for behavior



Children getting into frequent altercations- verbal or physical; those exhibiting signs of aggression; always blaming others for their problems or worrying about their popularity can't be brushed aside. Don't underestimate the role social media plays in this!

We each have a stake in understanding and addressing bullying behavior by working with the child. Determining the underlying cause and implementing corrective action is a win for everyone. Left unchecked it's a recipe for possible future domestic abuse.

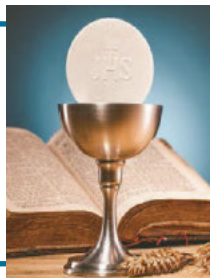

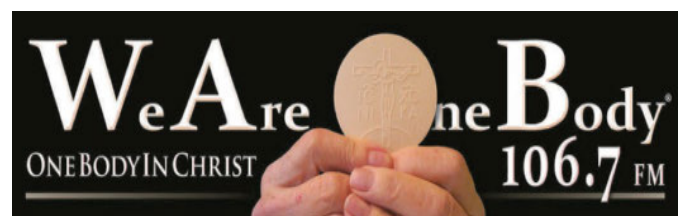
NOCTURNAL ADORATION—*Be one with Jesus in Eucharistic Adoration*

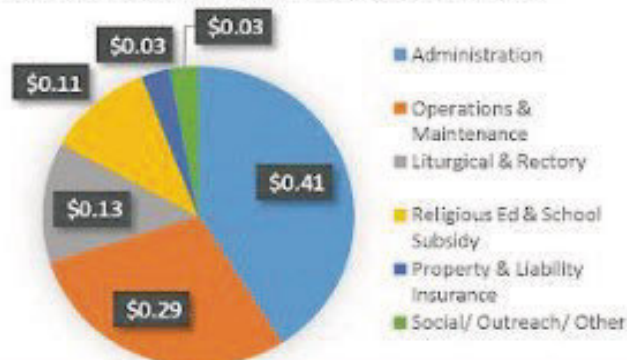

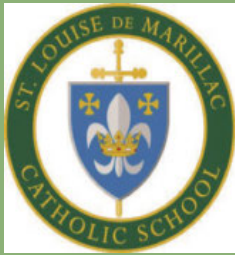

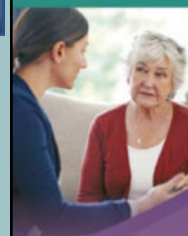
