

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER JEFF:

Welcome New PPC Members!

It has been a joy to collaborate with the St. Catherine Labouré Parish Pastoral Council (PPC). This group of 12 parishioners is a critical part of our parish as they advise me and support numerous parish initiatives. We recently had 2 openings on the PPC. I am most pleased to announce that I have asked Nikki Eckenrode and Bill Collins to join the PPC as its newest members. I look forward to all that they will bring to our council. Please join me in welcoming them!

Daily Mass Attendance

Anytime there is change, there are not only challenges, but also opportunities. I'm proud of how our parish has responded in such a positive way to our new daily Mass schedule. Although we changed the daily Masses at the beginning of October, we are seeing, not only the same total attendance as before our changes, but on some days, greater attendance than before the changes! The response to the new noon Masses on Tuesday and Thursday at St. Joan's and the 7pm Wednesday Mass at St. Louise has been outstanding. This response clearly shows a need that our parish has addressed.

Weekend Mass Attendance

Many have commented on the fuller pews and greater participation at our weekend Masses. Here is the proof that what we are experiencing is real: Each October, the Diocese of Pittsburgh requires every parish to take a count of the attendance at each of the weekend Masses. This count provides the Diocese with details on attendance trends for all parishes and the Diocese on a whole. When I reviewed our parish numbers for this year, it is with great joy that I can say we had 413 more people in attendance at our weekend Masses the weekend of 10/22/2023 this year, compared to the same weekend of 10/23/2022 last year. This is an increase of more than 20%! Even when comparing these numbers with the same weekend of September of this year (9/24/23), we have experienced an increase in attendance of almost 200 individuals in just one month's time. May we continue this good work and embrace the growth with praise and thanksgiving to God!

First 4 Months:

After my first 4 months of being your Pastor at St. Catherine Labouré Parish, I could never have guessed the many experiences and blessings that I have come across in such a short space of time. From the significant increase in Mass attendance, to the growth in numbers of our Faith Formation Program, to our new and revamped high school youth, young adult, and evangelization ministries, to the designing of our new parish coat of arms, to the soon to be published monthly parish magazine and our overall emphasis on parish wide communication, there is much to be excited and grateful about at our parish... and we are only getting started! The response to these initiatives has been nothing short of inspiring. I pray that we continue with joy and enthusiasm to be led by the Holy Spirit during this time of growth and excitement at our parish!

We continue to plan new projects, ministries, and opportunities for everyone at St. Catherine Laboure. If you are looking for a way to get involved or to help support the growth of our parish, please feel free to contact me. I am sure I can find something for you as we all continue to make improvements and grow our parish ministries together!





Liturgy of the Hours as the official liturgical prayer of the Church finds its

source in the Eucharist to sanctify all hours of our day. The Church invites the laity to join as one in the Body of Christ to pray the Liturgy of the Hours so that God's Word may be integrated into our daily lives in a prayer that is truly both ancient and ever new.

Morning Prayer with group recitation is held at Saint Louise Church after the 9:00am

Mass on Mondays and after the 7:00am Mass Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Easy to follow booklets are provided.

Funeral Liturgy Planners: In the Order of Christian Funerals, we read: When a member of Christ's body dies, the faithful are called to a ministry of consolation to those who have suffered a



loss of one they love. They are called to "comfort the mourning." It is within this call to "comfort the mourning" that Saint Catherine Labouré Parish is launching a new ministry, that of **Funeral Liturgy Planner**.

In this role, **Funeral Liturgy Planners** meet and assist families in preparing the Mass of Christian Burial that honors their loved one.

Their duties include:

- 1. Offering condolences and the prayers on behalf of Saint Catherine Labouré Parish Family.
- 2. Assisting families fill out the Saint Catherine Labouré Parish Funeral Liturgy Planning Guide and then passing that along to the appropriate staff.
- 3. Attending the funeral Mass to greet, seat the deceased family members and guide the readers and gift bearers during the funeral Mass.



Type II Diabetes—Could I Have It?

Type II diabetes occurs when your body develops insulin resistance or an inability to utilize insulin. Insulin is necessary to break down sugar. A deficiency causes sugar to accumulate in your blood.

DIABETES


Symptoms such as constant hunger, excessive thirst, frequent urination, general lack of energy or fatigue, unintended weight loss, blurred vision or pain/tingling/numbness in your hands or feet may develop.

A plethora of unrelated reasons could be responsible so these symptoms might understandably be overlooked or dismissed. However, with disease progression, symptoms become more pronounced or additive and may be irreversible.

For those believing that doctor visits are needed only when ill—take heed: if you are experiencing these symptoms over weeks or months, make that appointment! A blood test can confirm if diabetes is the culprit! Should it be Type II, the sooner it's diagnosed and treated, the better your outcome.


