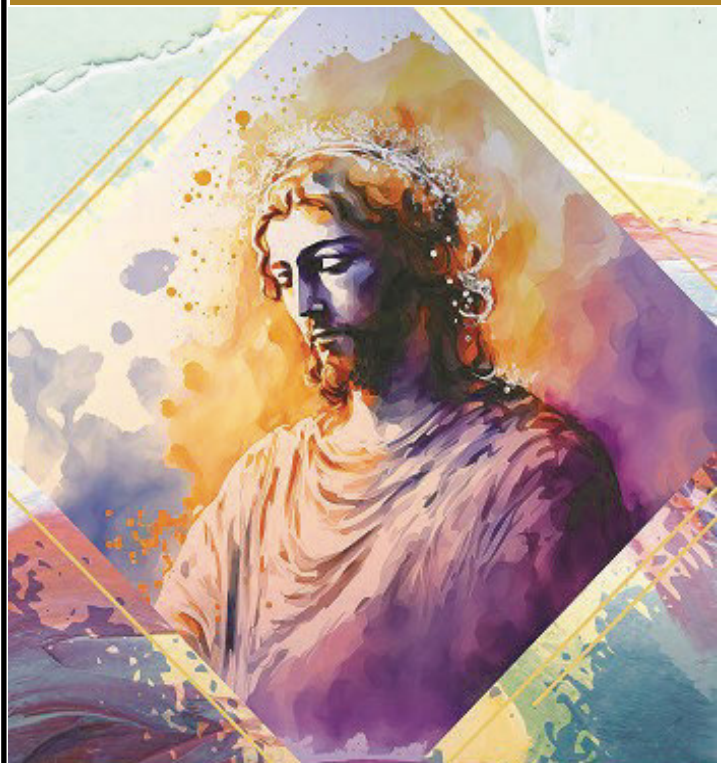

# FROM THE DESK OF FATHER JEFF

## Catholic Schools Week:

We kickoff Catholic Schools week at the 10am Mass with our St. Louise de Marillac School students participating in the Mass. As a parish we are blessed to have a thriving school on campus. Many know of the amazing education that St. Louise offers, just one of many reasons there continues to be a waiting list for prospective students. Thank you to all of the faculty and parents who make the sacrifices necessary to provide our children Catholic schooling, at both the grade school and high school levels.

The benefits of a Catholic Education are countless. The need to support Catholic Education for our future is critical. When I think back to my experience of Catholic Education, I look with such gratitude and amazement. I could not be any more thankful for this gift of a Catholic education.

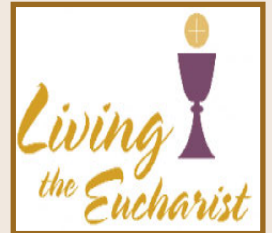

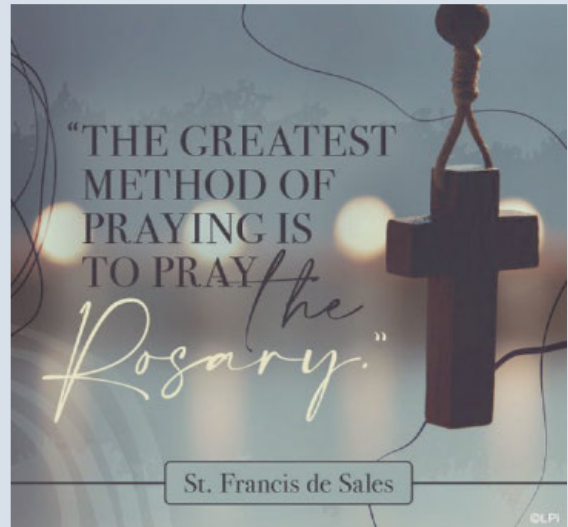

### What is the Benedictine Pastor's Award?

A \$2,000 grant, renewable for four years, awarded to students who are registered members of parishes at which Benedictine monks of Saint Vincent Archabbey serve or parishes identified as partners in the Benedictine mission.

Students must apply and be accepted to Saint Vincent to be eligible to receive this award. The pastor of the parish is asked to submit a letter attesting that the student has been an active member of the parish for at least one year. The deadline to apply is February 1, 2024 with a letter of recommendation from the pastor.

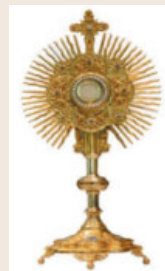

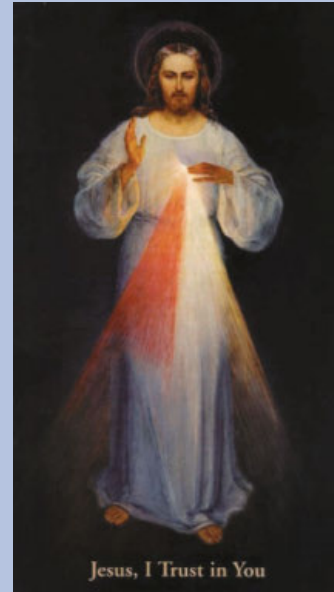
### Virtue in Action by Grace - The Path Toward Holiness

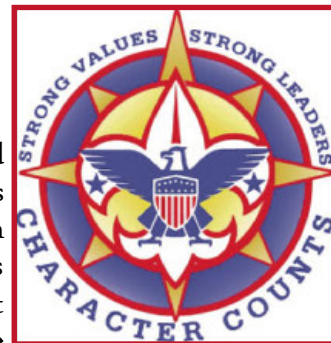

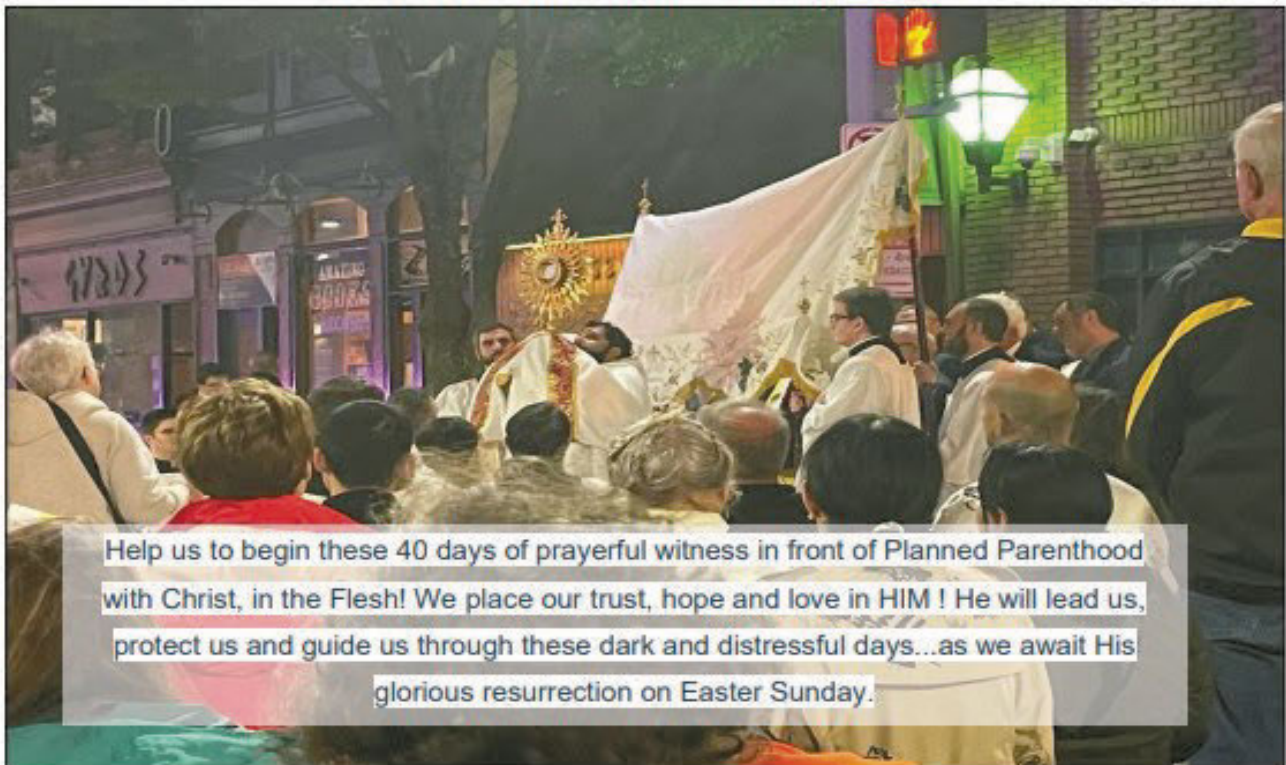

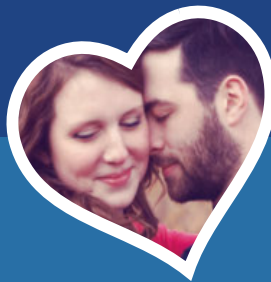
