# Welcome to Nursery

## Drop off and Pick Up

- Students are dropped off at the side door of the main school building, Clinton Avenue. Drop off is from 8:30-8:50am. Caregivers remain in vehicles, students will be escorted into the classrooms by staff members.
- Dismissal for full day nursery students will be at 2:45pm. Parents should park in the main parking lot and walk across to the side door of the main building to pick up their child. Please do not park in the side parking lot since there will be buses in this lot. Please line up on the right side (when facing doors) and the children will be called one at a time as you approach the doors.
- Dismissal for half day students will be at 12:30pm. Parents will come to the main entrance of the school building where your child will be brought to you.
- On scheduled early dismissal days, the children will all be dismissed from the side door at 11:45am.
