For students entering Grade 7, there is no teacher-structured summer reading; it is time for students to self-select what they will read.

This summer, students will be required to read **two** novels of their choosing and appropriate to their grade level. Students are asked to read one fiction and one nonfiction biography or autobiography and complete the attached graphic organizers accordingly. These organizers are to be handed in the first day of school in preparation for a brief project that will be assigned the first week of school.

Throughout this school year, the students will be strengthening their close reading skills through direct interaction with various texts as well through the iReady learning platform. We will be reading a variety of short stories, a collection of Greek myths and the full length novel *Freak the Mighty* by Rodman Philbrick. As a result, I respectfully ask that the students **not** read this novel for their summer reading assignments.
