Immunization Requirements for Pre-Kindergarten Students

Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter Prekindergarten and attend school. Please check with your health care provider to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations.

Required Immunizations for Pre-Kindergarten

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	3
Hepatitis B	3
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	4
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	1
Varicella (Chickenpox)	1
Hemophilus Influenzae	1 to 4
Pneumococcal Conjugate	1 to 4

Proof of immunization should be sent to the school nurse prior to the start of school.

Proof of immunization must be any 1 of the 3 items listed below:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- Immunization Registry report (NYSIIS or CIR from NYC) from your health care provider or your county health department
- A blood test (titer) lab report that proves your child is immune to the diseases
 - For varicella (chickenpox), a note from your health care provider (MD, NP, PA) which says your child had the disease is also acceptable.
