Dear Parent(s):

We are happy that you have chosen St. Agnes Cathedral School to assist you in educating your child. We believe in the uniqueness of each child and foster a safe and respectful learning environment. The school incorporates a holistic approach to education: academic excellence, affective and creative development, as well as, the spiritual, physical, emotional, and social growth of its students. Because of these beliefs St. Agnes Cathedral School provides an educational program which enables each student to achieve his/her full potential. This process will not be successful without your cooperation and support of the school's religious, academic and extra-curricular programs.

At the time of registration, we want you to become fully cognizant of the commitment we ask of you. If we are to assist you, the primary educator, we must work together. As a Catholic school, we are dedicated to Christian formation. This process **must** involve you. Parent meetings dealing with Sacramental programs must be attended. Participation and attendance at Sunday Mass is strongly encouraged.

Academic success is incumbent upon our ability to meet the individual needs of your child. Acceptance to St. Agnes will be contingent upon the receipt of **all** previous school records. A release form has been included in the registration packet. Notice of acceptance will be forwarded to you within two weeks after your screening date.

Your participation in Parent/Teacher Conferences is of the utmost importance. Scheduled conferences include two assessment card meetings which are held at the completion of the first and second trimesters.

The health and safety of the children is of grave importance. Please read carefully the letter which accompanies the required health forms. Your child **will not** be admitted without the necessary immunizations and physical examination.

Lunch aides are employed to supervise the students (grades K-8) in the cafeteria and the schoolyard. If you wish your child to remain in school during lunch, a family fee will be exacted. This fee is payable in August.

Tuition payments are due the first week of each month. The first month's tuition and all fees are due August 1, 2024. The following are **NON-REFUNDABLE** fees:

Kindergarten: \$300; \$150 registration fee and \$150 towards tuition

Grades 1-7: \$150 registration fee

The present tuition schedule (2023-2024) is attached for your information. Tuition is payable over the course of eleven (11) months and is minimally increased each year.

Since tuition does not cover the cost of educating a child, each Catholic family registered at a parish within the Diocese is required to contribute a yearly minimum of \$550.00 in the Offertory collection. The Principal, in conjunction with Very Rev. Michael Duffy, will monitor these contributions.

St. Agnes is committed to providing quality education. It is our hope that by creating opportunities for students to experience, understand, judge and decide, a total loving Christian person will evolve.
