Paper Bag Book Report

You will complete a paper bag book report on the novel you choose from the summer reading list. Using a medium-sized gift bag and the guideline below, complete the following tasks:

On the front of the bag: Create a new cover for your novel.! Choose your favorite scene from the story and draw it on a separate piece of paper. Attach the paper to the front of your bag. Be sure to include the book's title, author, and illustrator on your cover.

<u>On the back</u>: attach a summary of your book. Be sure that you include the beginning, middle, and end of the story. This needs to be a minimum of twelve sentences (four sentences for each part of the story).


<u>On one side of your bag</u>: include the main characters and the setting. Write a minimum of one sentence describing each main character. Write at least three sentences describing the setting, time, and place of the story.

On the other side of the bag: include the conflict and solution. If the story has more than conflict and solution include only your favorite. The conflict and solution part of your project needs to be a minimum of six sentences total.

<u>Inside the bag:</u> include three small items that represent your book's setting, plot, or characters. Explain their meaning on a separate sheet of paper and put the sheet inside of your bag along with the three items you chose.

On the bottom of your bag: attach your book recommendation. Be sure to shade in the amount of stars you would give the book and write whether or not you would recommend your book to a friend. This needs to be a minimum of three sentences.

Neatness: Be creative! Use construction paper, scrapbook items, stickers, fabric, and other craft supplies from home.



Attach a tag here to the handle with your first and last name.

Create a new book cover! Be sure to use your favorite scene from the story, not the actual book cover! Make sure that you include the title, author and illustrator.
