

As the Pandemic begins to lessen and restrictions are being eased, the time has come to have a "soft" opening of the Collaborative

churches that have been closed since the Pandemic began.

As of June 1st, St. Joseph - St. Therese and Our Lady of Fatima Churches will be available for any parishioner to use to schedule funerals and weddings (scheduling will continue to be made through the Central Office). St. Mary's will remain available for Funerals and Weddings also for any member of the Collaborative. All other sacramental ministrations will remain at St. Mary's for the time being.

It is hoped that we will have the assistance and collaboration of parishioners to make this happen. Those who exercise the ministry of Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Acolyte or Musician can exercise their ministry in any parish of the Collaborative. Ministry is for the service of the Church, Collaborative, and not for a particular church building.

Thank you for your attention to this announcement.

Graduates:

At this time of year we wish to congratulate all members of our Collaborative who have graduated this year. Whether from Grammar, High School or College this is an important commencement in your life. Be assured of our prayers for your future success as well as our prayers that you have much good health and happiness as you continue your journey in new ways.

Sign of Peace:

The sign of peace during Mass remains optional. Should you wish to exchange a sign or peace it should be one without touching or shaking hands with those not in your family. A bow or wave is more than sufficient.

Open Doors:

On the weekend of Father's Day all the doors of St. Mary's will be open for your convenience as you enter or leave church. Please note that there are collection receptacles at each door to receive your donations until we have ushers do the collection.

As we are now open to full capacity here at St. Mary's church, we need volunteers to help vacuum the church on a

weekly basis. The hope is that we get at least 4 or 5 volunteers so that each volunteer comes in once a month. If you are able to give us a couple of hours a week whether be morning or afternoon to help with this task, please contact the Central Office at 508-995-3593. Thank you!

Registration for Faith Formation 2021-22 begins...June 15th!!!!

We're getting this process underway earlier than what has been the custom so we can use the information to secure enough

catechists, spend time on their formation, plan assignments of space and order all materials and books at one time to keep costs down. Like last year, you can access the online registration portal through our website — www.ccnbn.org/youth-faith-formation — use your debit or credit card for payment and you'll be good to go for another year. For those who still wish to pay by check or cash, there will be a form available on the website to download and once it's filled out you can return it with payment to the Central Offices.

The fees for this year are \$35 per child in Eucharist/Grade 1, Grades 3-7 and Confirmation 1 (Grade 8) with a maximum of \$75 for 3 or more children from one family in those grades. Eucharist/Grade 2 and Confirmation 2 (Grade 9) have a fee of \$75 per child/teen but that includes their robe rental and the annual retreat. Please note that no family is ever turned away due to an inability to pay the fee. Simply contact the Director of Faith Formation to make arrangements.

You really will be helping us out by registering early...so don't delay!

After looking at the potential number of children and youth who will register for our program next year, we will need the following number of **new catechists** for these grade levels so we can once again meet in-person beginning in September:
