FOR OUR HOME-BOUND: Contact the Parish Office to receive Holy Communion at home if you are confined.

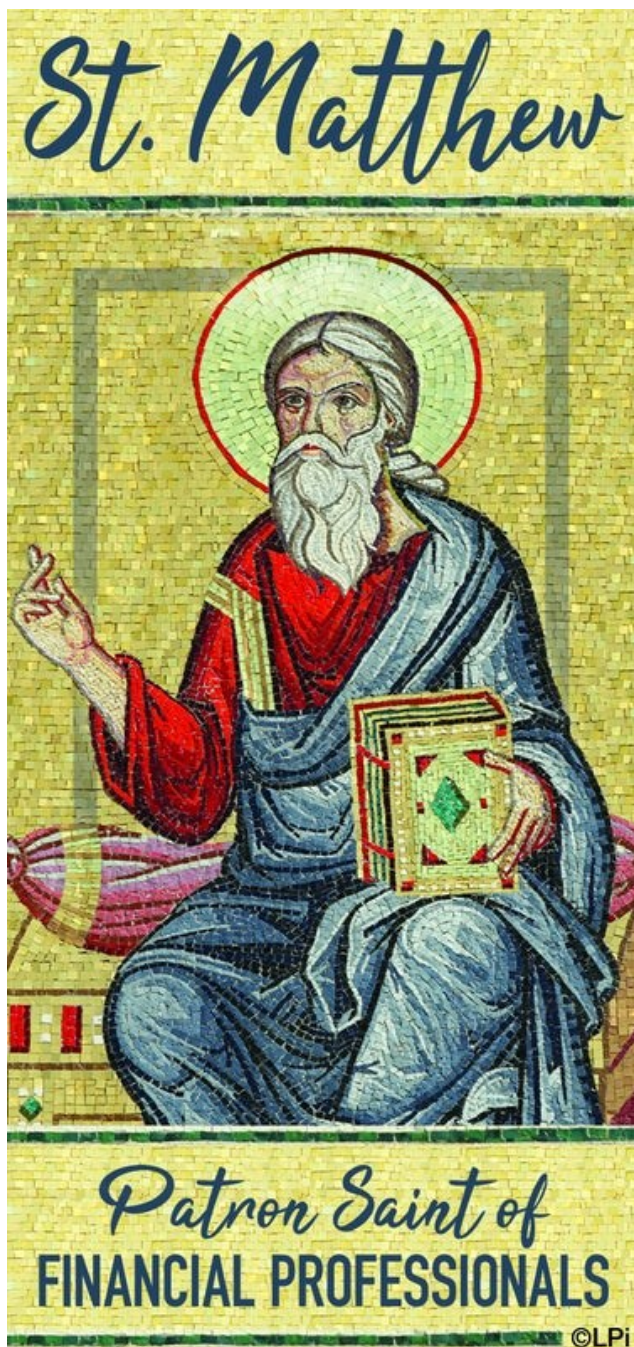
