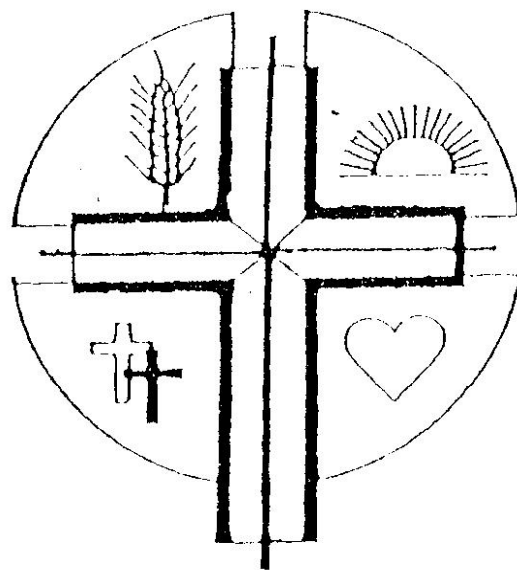

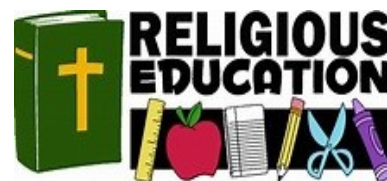
## Stewardship Moment
