Each student has been assigned a building in the village of Southampton.

Project will be will graded on: research, clear writing, two changes explained, model effort, and neatness.

Explain how a local historic building was first used and describe at least two ways it has changed.

Key words (remember these)

- historic — important because it is from long ago
- community — people who live nearby
- preserve — keep safe so it lasts
- adapt/adapted — changed to be used in a new way
- original use — what it was first built for
- renovation — fixing or updating a building
- landmark — a well-known building or place
- Look at old or recent pictures
- Check old maps or library records
- Ask neighbors or family who know the town

Writing (3 paragraphs)

Paragraph 1 — Say the building's name, when it was built, and its original use.

Paragraph 2 — Explain at least two changes the building had over time.

Paragraph 3 — Say how the building helps our community now and why it should be preserved.

Project — Shoe-box model

- **Build a model of your building using a shoe box and materials you already have (no buying).**
- **Use paper, cardboard, glue, tape, markers, fabric scraps, bottle caps, etc.**
- **Make the outside look like the real building. You may show one inside change if you want.**

- ☐ Three written paragraphs (neat and complete)

- ☐ Shoe-box model of the building
- ☐ Any pictures or notes from interviews or maps (optional)

2. When was it built? (estimate if needed.)

3. What was its original use?

4. Who used it when it was new? (families, workers, students, travelers)

5. List two ways the building has changed (inside layout, purpose, added rooms, kept outside look, etc.).

6. Why is this building important to our community today?
