Information about this will be sent to you. **Please label your child's belongings with his or her name.** We ask that you cover your child's text books with clear contact .

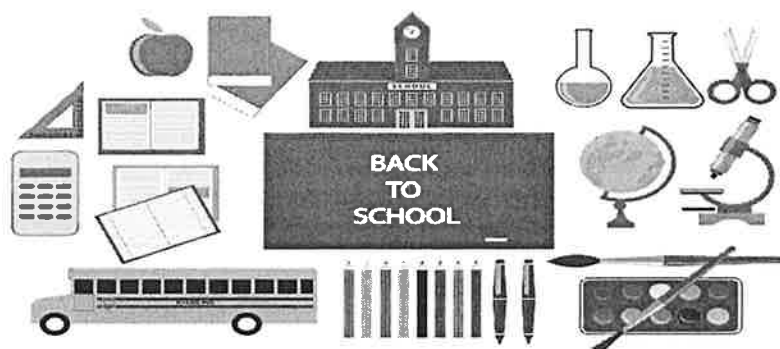

These items should be brought in during the first week of school:

2 sturdy pocket folders and 1 composition book for each subject area, except for **ELA and Math, and Science** where you will need **2 composition books**. No orange folder is needed.

Try to find the colors listed below, as it will help you stay organized. TIP: During August, Staples usually has composition books in every color for 50 cents each.

- ☐ Blue: ELA (2 folders and 2 notebooks)
- ☐ Yellow: Math (2 folders and 2 notebooks)
- ☐ Green: Science/Health (2 folders and 2 notebooks)
- ☐ Red: Social Studies
- ☐ Purple: Religion
- ☐ Black: Spanish
- ☐ Orange: Homework (1 notebooks)
- ☐ 3 dozen black erasable pens
- ☐ 1 dozen red pens
- ☐ 3 dozen #2 pencils (Dixon Ticonderoga or USA Gold Pencils recommended)
- ☐ 1 rubber eraser (white "Magic Rub" recommended)
- ☐ 1 pair of student scissors
- ☐ 6 yellow highlighters
- ☐ 1 dozen colored pencils (no markers or gel pens for coloring, please)
- ☐ 2 black Sharpies (no other colors)
