This is how it works:

If a student reads 6 or more books over the summer, that student will receive a **N.U.T. Pass** (No Uniform Today) to be used during the school year.

The lower grade class (K-3), the intermediate class (4-6) and the junior high class (7-8) that reads the most books in their respective grade levels will celebrate with a **dress** down day of their choice!

Special prizes will be awarded to the students that read the most books in their grade.

Medals will be awarded as follows:

K-3rd grade: Student must read a minimum of 20 books to receive a medal.

 $4^{th} - 6^{th}$ grade: Student must read a minimum of 10 books to receive a medal.

7th – 8th grade: Student must read a minimum of 6 books (with at least 150 pages) to receive a medal.

If the student body reads over 11,000 books, the school will celebrate with a **SCHOOL SPIRIT DAY!**
