






Volunteer Service Credit (VSC) Frequently Asked Questions

12 Hours + 8 Raffle Tickets = \$400 Credit

What is the Volunteer Service Credit (VSC)?

St. William the Abbot offers a tuition discount in the amount of \$400 to families who:

- 1. Perform at least 12 hours of volunteering, and
- 2. Sell at least 8 raffle tickets for the "VSC Raffle"

What volunteering hours count towards the VSC?

• All volunteering opportunities that are listed on the VSC website, lunch/recess duty and Middle School Sports Coaching.

What volunteering hours do NOT count towards the VSC?

• Class mom activities, field trips and party chaperones, and volunteers who attend in-school and classroom parties do not count towards these hours.

Are family volunteer hours counted separately?

• No! All volunteers linked under the family account in our VSC system will count towards the 12 hours. That means Mom, Dad, Grandma and Grandpa, as long as they are all VIRTUS trained, can contribute!

What is the timeline for qualifying for the VSC?

- Our VSC program runs each year from April 1st through March 31st.
- Volunteering hours worked between 4/1/2023 and 3/31/2024 will count towards the 23/24 VSC program, with the exception of lunch/recess duty. Only current school year hours (September March) will count towards the 23/24 VSC program.
- The VSC raffle tickets (to be provided in late fall) must be sold by 3/31/2024.
- Families who qualify for the credit will receive the discount on their May 2024 tuition bill. This will automatically be reflected in your FACTS account.

What if I volunteer for more than 12 hours? Can I be exempt from the fundraising (raffle ticket) portion?

• To qualify for the credit, families must meet both the volunteering and fundraising requirements, regardless of how many volunteer hours are performed, as both are equally important!

Are there enough volunteering opportunities for all families to meet this requirement?

• Yes! The VSC website is consistently updated with both in school and out of school volunteer opportunities, including morning, afternoon, evening and weekend slots! Below is a list of opportunities published in VSC between April 2023 and December 2023, not counting all of our dedicated lunch volunteers! Some of these events are currently open for registration!


