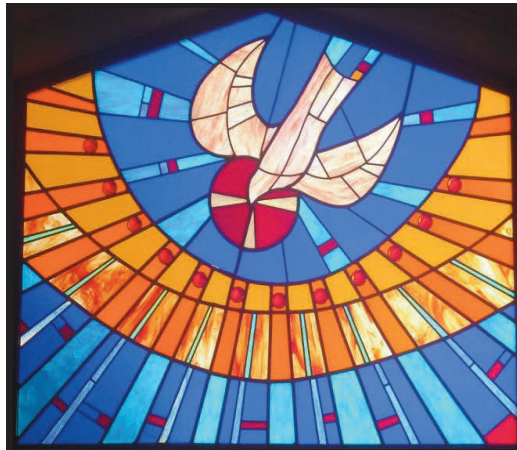

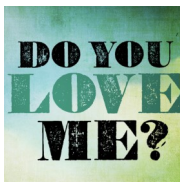

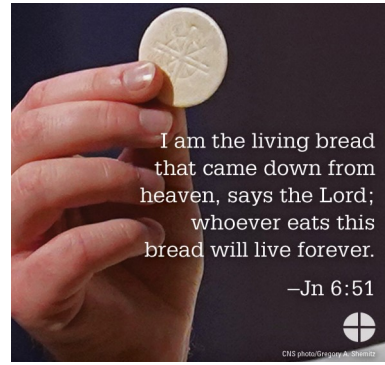

Beacons of Light

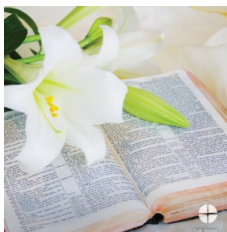
