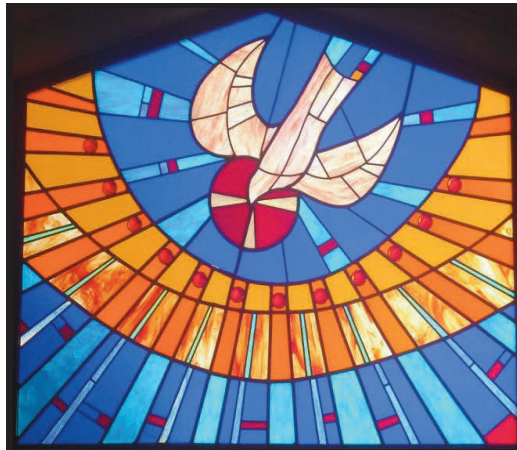

The Real Presence

Secret # 5: We don't just receive. The phrase "receiving communion" can suggest a passive reality. It can reinforce the concept that we are not really "doing" anything, that God is the one who is doing; we are simply receiving. But Christ is doing something! He is calling us to not merely receive Communion but to enter into union with Him, to be completely one with Him.

When used to denote the sacrament of the Eucharist, it suggests a similar union to that which is effected by the sacrament of marriage, where "the two become one flesh." The Eucharist is called "Holy Communion" because by this sacrament we unite ourselves to Christ, who makes us sharers in his Body and Blood to form a single body. (CCC 1331) We must give ourselves to Christ as He gives Himself to us. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." (Jn 6:56)

St. Francis of Assisi, in a beautiful meditation on the Eucharist exhorted his brothers to "See the humility of God, brothers, and pour out your hearts before Him! Humble yourselves that you may be exalted by Him! Hold back nothing of yourselves for yourselves, that He who gives Himself totally to you may receive you totally!"

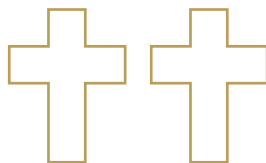
