



The Real Presence

Secret # 7: There's no limit to the number of times we can receive. No limit to how many times we can receive?! Every time we desire to receive Holy Communion we have a choice between two ways of receiving.. In his Summa, St. Thomas Aquinas calls this two kinds of eating: sacramental and spiritual. Sacramental eating is when we receive with at least some fundamental understanding of the sacrament and the intent to receive it. Spiritual eating is when our sacramental eating is accompanied by a real longing for union with Christ, thus we receive not only the sacrament itself but also the sacramental effect whereby we are spiritually joined to Christ in love. St Thomas goes on to explain that this complete spiritual Communion can even take place when we are unable to receive sacramentally, because "the effect of a sacrament can be secured if it is received by desire." This means that, in addition to the times when we can actually receive the sacrament of the Eucharist, we can also receive spiritually through our desire for the sacrament, uniting our hearts to the Heart of Jesus in the Eucharist. This is the reality that is expressed in Secret 7. Yes, there is a limit to the number of times we can receive the Eucharist sacramentally, but there is no limit to the times we can receive spiritually. However, spiritual Communion is not a substitute for sacramental Communion, but a very real anticipation and extension of its fruits. There can be no substitute for regular sacramental communion, and our spiritual Communion must always have sacramental communion as its goal. St. Thomas teaches that: The actual receiving of this sacrament produces the effect more fully than the desiring of it. Even by desiring it, a person receives grace whereby he is spiritually alive...but when the sacrament itself is really received, grace is increased and the life of the spirit perfected and made whole by union with God. "Union with God!!!" And that's what its all about!
