



The Real Presence

MIRACLE IN WALLDURN, GERMANY 1330

On a day in 1330, in the city of Walldurn, Germany, a priest, as he usually did daily, went to say Mass in the parish church. Everything was as normal for the first part of the Mass. Immediately after the consecration of the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus a miracle occurred! As the priest lowered the chalice back down onto the altar, he accidentally spilled some of the Precious Blood on the corporal. He was very distressed about the mishap, but immediately the spilled Blood of Christ formed an image of Jesus on the Cross! Also, small images of the head of Christ crowned with thorns appeared all around the miraculous Crucifix image! The priest, stunned, did not know what to do. Should he show everyone the miracle or just keep it to himself? He decided not to tell anyone else about it and kept the corporal with the miraculous images hidden under the altar! Years passed and the priest was nearing his death. He decided that he had better tell everyone what had happened before it was too late. Upon seeing the miracle, people spread the word far and wide. Years later, the decision was made that a larger church should be built at the site and it was completed in 1728. In 1962, Pope St. John XXIII elevated the church to a minor basilica.
