

### The Real Presence

THE MIRACLE OF ALCALA' DE HENARES, SPAIN 1597

Early in 1597, the Jesuit church of Alcala' de Henares was visited by an unidentified man who confessed that he belonged to a Moorish group which had perpetrated a number of thefts in Catholic churches. Stricken in conscience, he told the Jesuit priest, Padre Juarez, how he and his companions had stolen sacred vessels which they had then sold for profit. He then revealed the horrible sacrileges he and the others had inflicted upon the Hosts that they found in the vessels. He handed Padre Juarez a thick piece of paper in which 24 Hosts, all very white, had been wrapped. Padre Juarez related the details of the recovery to another Jesuit priest, both of whom decided that, not knowing if the man's story was trust worthy or if the Hosts had ben consecrated, decided to put them in a box in the church's pantry instead of the tabernacle. Atop the box they placed instructions that when the Hosts became spoiled, they should be destroyed by water or fire. Eleven years later, in 1608, the provincial father and Padre Juarez examined the Hosts and found that they had retained their whiteness and freshness. They were then placed in a box in a subterranean vault next to a number of unconsecrated hosts to see if humidity would spoil them. In only a few months the unconsecrated hosts were found to have spoiled while the original Hosts were still fresh and pure and were finally placed in the tabernacle of the Jesuit chapel and eventually transferred to the Holy Magistral Church. When the Spanish Civil War began in 1936, the monstrance containing the 24 miraculously preserved Hosts was hidden by a priest in a secret location in the church. The church was destroyed during the war, but either before or sometime during its destruction, a priest who knew the hiding place of the Hosts entered the building to save them, but was discovered and assassinated. While it is known that the Hosts were recovered from their hiding place in the church, their present safety and whereabouts are unknown. It is the prayer of the people that the Hosts can be found and enshrined in the newly restored basilica.
