The Sacrament of Baptism

Attendance at a baptismal class is required for parents who desire baptism for their infant. Godparents must both be Catholic, fully initiated into the Church at least 16 years old, and practicing their faith. The date and time of baptism will be determined by the pastor. Baptismal preparation classes can be attended prior to the birth of your child. Please contact the parish office to inquire.

The RCIA: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a process by which an adult enters into the Catholic Church. RCIA classes begin in the fall of the year. The sacraments of initiation are received at the Solemn Vigil in the Holy Night of Easter. Please call the parish office for more information.

The Sacrament of the Eucharist

The children of the parish are prepared to receive their First Holy Communion in the second grade. The reception of the sacrament takes place at a Sunday Mass in the spring of each year. If your child is beyond the second grade and has not yet received their First Holy Communion, please call the parish for information about preparation to receive the sacrament.

The Sacrament of Confirmation

The Youth of the parish are prepared to receive the sacrament of Confirmation in grades 8 and 9. It is a two year program. The youth will receive the sacrament from the Bishop of Lansing in October of their 2nd year in a regional Confirmation Mass. The sacrament of Confirmation completes full initiation into the Catholic Church. If you are an adult and have not been confirmed please call the parish office to inquire about the reception of the sacrament.

The Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation

The children of the parish are prepared to receive their First Penance in the second grade prior to their First Holy Communion.

The sacrament of Penance is celebrated on Saturday from 3:00-4:30 p.m.

A Communal Penance Service is celebrated during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

The Sacrament of the Sick

The sacrament of the Sick is available anytime upon request. It is intended for those who are facing serious physical or mental illness, surgery, or the declining effects of aging. A communal service of the sacrament is celebrated on the First Friday of each month at the 11:00 a.m. Mass. Holy Communion is taken to the sick and home-bound upon request.

St. Catherine Laboure Church attends to the Catholics in the local care facilities.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

A period of at least nine months is required for marriage preparation. Scheduling the wedding date takes place after the initial meeting with the pastor. If there has been a previous marriage by either party, Catholic or not, a declaration of nullity must be sought through the Diocese of Lansing before the marriage can occur. Please call the office to inquire.

Statement from the Parish Administrator



Greetings to one and all. As the temporary administrator of St. Catherine I wanted to keep you updated on some recent developments.



On June 1st, Queen of the Miraculous Medal's bookkeeper Kelli Rohloff assumed charge of the financial transactions of the parish in replacement of the Diocese who had been fulfilling these duties ever since Emily Wilson retired in the parish office. The parish was paying a modest monthly service fee to the Diocese for accounting services. That same fee will now be paid to Queens. Kelli Rohloff has prepared the parish budget for the coming fiscal year and she will be working closely with parish staff to make sure all needs are being met in a timely fashion.

On June 25-26, you are invited to come to Mass at St. Catherine to bid farewell to our Pastor Fr. Timothy Krzyzaniak. Father has asked to concelebrate these Masses with Fr. Bill Lugger who kindly continues his weekend Mass assistance with us. Fr. Krzyzaniak will be entering senior status with the Diocese which means he can retire from the duties of parish administration. On behalf of all the parishioners at St. Catherine, we thank Father Krzyzaniak for his years of service and we wish him health, holiness and happiness as he begins a new chapter in his priesthood. Per Father's wishes there will be no reception. If you wish to leave a card or acknowledgement you can send them to the office or bring them with you to Mass that weekend.

Many of you may be wondering what happens next now that Fr. Krzyzaniak is leaving? I will continue as administrator and hopefully Fr. Bill will continue to supply weekend help for as long as he is able. It is not possible at this time for the Bishop to assign a new resident pastor to St. Catherine due to shrinking numbers of priests and so many priests nearing retirement. St. Catherine is entering the Jackson Grouping for Realigning Resources for Mission this summer. I have been asked by Bishop Boyea to serve as the moderator of the priests in the grouping and will be overseeing administration of all sites working with my brother priests assigned to the grouping. One of the newly ordained, Fr. Tyler Arens, is being assigned to the grouping. As a new priest he has to live with a mentor priest and that will be Fr. Tim Nelson at St. Mary Star of the Sea in downtown Jackson. The priests in the grouping have until December to submit plans and proposals for the grouping to the Diocese. Meetings are ongoing to determine how we priests will go on mission together to better serve all the souls entrusted to our care. The needs of the parish will not be lost in the mix. I remain available for spiritual counsel, anointings and last rites, pastoral appointments, marriage preparation, funerals, annulments, etc.

Blessings to one and all and to Fr. Krzyzaniak. You are a priest forever!
