What is Fasting?

Fasting is the <u>reduction of one's intake of food</u>. The Church defines fasting as one regular meal a day, and two smaller ones which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity (Eating a more simple and less extravagant diet than we normally would.). No snacking is permitted.

The Catholic Church teaches that all people are obliged by God to perform some penance for their sins, and that these acts of penance are both personal and corporeal, depriving yourself of both the good and the bad things for the glory of God. We are to fast and abstain from meat, on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and Fridays in Lent.

What is Abstinence? Abstinence refers to refraining from meat (or another type of food). The law of abstinence prohibits eating the flesh, marrow and blood products of such animals (cows, pigs, goats, lambs, etc.) and birds (turkey, chicken etc.) which constitute flesh meat. Today by-products produced such milk, butter, eggs, cheese are permitted.

Canon Law 1252 -All persons who have completed their fourteenth year are bound by the law of abstinence; all adults are bound by the law of fast up to the beginning of their sixtieth year. Nevertheless, pastors and parents are to see to it that minors who are not bound by the law of fast and abstinence are educated in an authentic sense of penance.

Pastor's Letter My dear parishioners, As I write these lines to you I realize

we have entered an unusual time in the history of our church. Since our foundation 2000 years ago by Jesus Christ we have offered the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, often in secret because of religious persecution, as is the case in China and North Korea today. Now, because of the Coronavirus we are not offering Mass publicly as decreed by Bishop Vasquez, in an effort to stem the virus. All priests will be offering Mass privately daily for their parishioners.

This, I know, is a real hardship for all of us but do know that although the Blessed Sacrament Chapel is closed, the church will remain open for private adoration, individual Stations and prayer from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. each day, with confessions daily in the church from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The advertised Parish Mission which was from March 29– 31 is canceled.

We place each of you under the protection of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart.






