Pastor's Letter Dear Parishioners,

As we enter our third weekend celebrating Holy Mass in our church and parish center, it is with gratitude that I express our thanks to our ushers who assist in directing you to the pews, ensuring that the prescribed distance and wearing of masks are observed. It is all so strange when during our lifetime we have always chosen where we place ourselves for Mass.

During the **10:00 A.M. Mass** in the church **this weekend** we have invited this year's High School Catholic graduates to attend to thank God for their education and ask His blessing and guidance for their future studies. Therefore we will allocate **a pew for each student and their family members** (maximum of 8). This will mean that very few spaces for other parishioners will be available in the church but may be available in the parish center. If, and I hope not, we run out of spaces, you can join with us by sitting in your car in the parking lot and we will signal to you by ringing bells at the **Consecration** and again when to come into the church or parish center for **Holy Communion**.

And now to add further to my, and your stress, **Confirmation** will take place during the **5:30 p.m. Mass** on **Saturday, 30th May** in our church. We can **only** accommodate: the **candidate, sponsor** and **parents** in our pews. No siblings, grandparents or other family members. So again, they can attend Mass in the parish center.

Our First Communions on **Sunday, 31st May** will be at **3 p.m.** in the church and again **only** the **child and parents** may be present in order to fit everyone in the church. How you, as parents, cope with this situation, needs inspiration about who will look after your other children and who will relate this info to grandparents who have been looking forward to their grandchild's First Communions for years. I think I'll disappear until after the ceremony. We will upload **videos** of all our ceremonies for our Web page.

May God be with us all, specially those who have the Virus and those who are lonely in our hospitals, with brave staff caring for them.





