



EIM Policies require all clergy, religious, seminarians, employees and adult volunteers serving in a ministry requiring EIM compliance to submit an EIM Application for Ministry (one-time only) and attend an EIM Workshop at least once every three years.

Online EIM training is available at http://www.austindiocese.org/ workshop for persons needing to update/renew their EIM compliance; the training page includes instructions on how to login to your existing EIM account to find information you will need in order to receive credit for completing the training. New employees and new volunteers currently active in ministry must submit the EIM Application at www.eappsdb.com/austin (as a First Time Applicant) and attend an in-person EIM Workshop (as of Jan. 1 new applicants may not use the online EIM training for their initial EIM compliance requirement). 




