



Dear Parishioners,

Having consulted with many parishioners and under the guidance of Bishop Vasquez, I believe the time has come to begin opening all the pews in our church so that we will once again have one place to assemble together as we offer the sacrifice of the Mass. We have tried our best to ensure that we observed the recommendations by our Diocese, who consulting the scientific and medical experts, which urged our parishioners to wear masks and keep social distancing while on parish property. Thank you for making those among us who suffer with low immune systems feel that attending our Masses, we were safe from Covid-19. Personally I did appreciate those who wore masks after my operation for the removal of my lung last October. I felt safe in our parish.

So from the weekend of <u>29/30 May</u>, we ask that you find your own way to a pew, while trying to observe social distancing and having the option of wearing masks, always conscious of the basic commandment "wish and do no harm to another".
