Prayer is generally thought of as an appeal to someone who is in charge for something that we want. We know we should pray in thanksgiving, in adoration and praise, but mostly we rely on petitions. In developed countries like America, our education and scientific advances allow us to think we are in charge—more or less. The list of what God can help with gets narrower and narrower, as we try to fix and figure everything out on our own.

But God is still ultimately in charge. Today's teaching on the Our Father is a good place to return to get a biblical, spiritual perspective. What's the perspective? It's not about me, but we. Don't get me wrong, we can pray about OUR needs but God (who is community/Trinity) teaches us through this prayer the context:

- ♦ "give US this day OUR daily bread"
- ♦ "forgive US OUR trespasses as WE forgive those who trespass against US"
- ♦ "and lead US not into temptation but deliver US from evil."

Pretty clear, huh?

Us. Our. We.

Hopefully our prayer includes more "us, our and we" instead of "me and mine".

After all, it is called the "OUR Father".

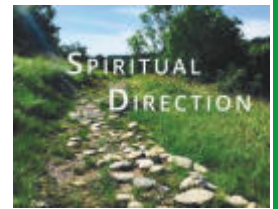

Engaged? Are You Starting to Plan Your Wedding? Terrific!

The Church is excited to assist you in preparing for your lifelong commitment! Some quick points to be aware of:

- Marriage preparation usually begins *at least six months prior* to a desired wedding date.
- No dates are scheduled until the couple meets with the pastor and fills out the necessary documents for marriage.
- If one or both have been in a previous marriage *regardless of denomination or marriage by a justice of the peace*, a Decree of Nullity (Annulment) will need to be obtained.

The best thing to do is contact the Church as soon as you are engaged so that we can help you right from the start!

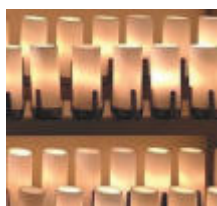

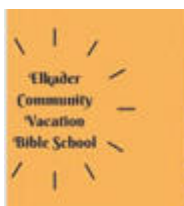
