Order of Christian Initiation of Children

St. Mary Catholic Parish, 2022-23

For: Children 8 years old and older who have not received any Sacraments in the Catholic Church (who need Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist) or who were baptized in another Christian denomination and now wish to join the Catholic Church

Because these children are past the age of reason, our Church requires them to freely consent
to receiving the Sacraments and to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church (not just receive
Baptism, but all 3 Sacraments of Initiation)

What OCIC is:

- Weekly meetings to learn about the Catholic faith and how to be a disciple of Jesus—either Wednesday afternoons (4:00-4:45) or Sunday afternoons (12:45-1:30), meeting in the Conference Room of the Parish Office
- Participation in the Rites of OCIC/OCIA—including the Rite of Acceptance on the 3rd Sunday of Advent, the Rite of Sending and the Rite of Election on the 1st Sunday of Lent, the Scrutiny Rites during Lent, and reception of the Sacraments at the Easter Vigil Mass (April 8, 2023)
- **Parental involvement** to strengthen parents and family in their Catholic faith—the best option is for parents to attend OCIA classes on Tuesday nights (6:30-8:00pm)
- **Participation in St. Mary Parish**—attendance at Mass on weekends and getting involved in other activities that connect the family to the parish (Religious Education, etc.)
