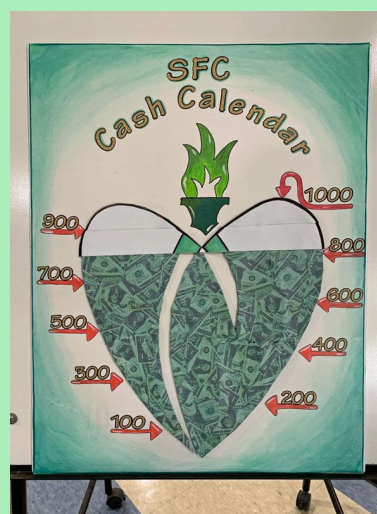
## Cash Calendars Update
