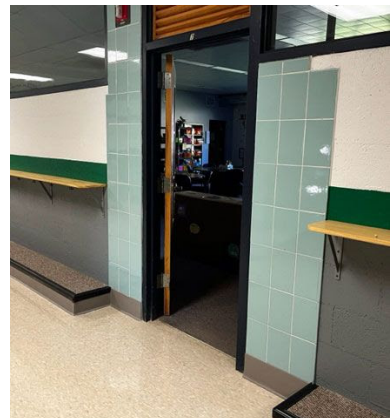

Tile Painting - Help Needed

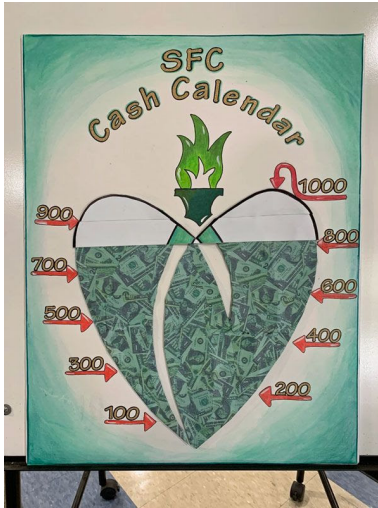
We are planning two days to paint over the teal blue tile. It's our last step to finish up hallways, and we need your help.

Tuesday, October 31st in the Adoration Chapel

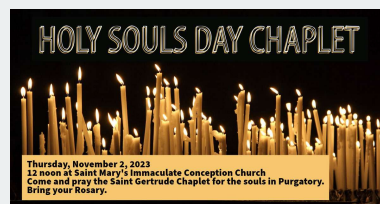

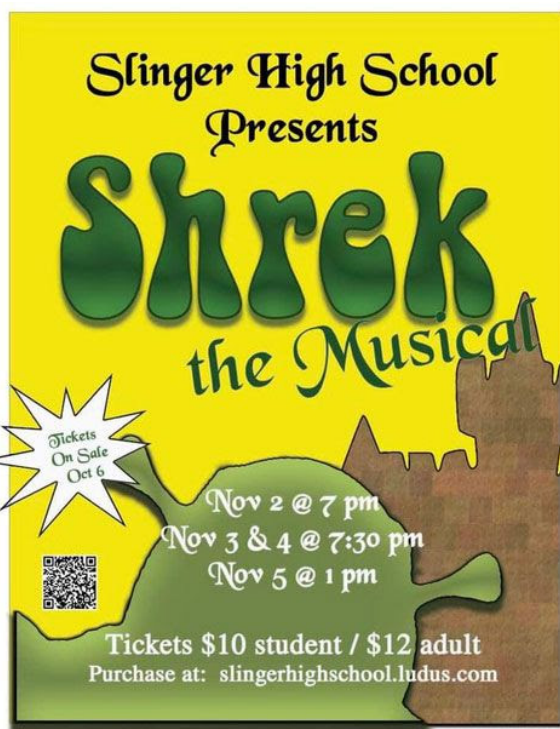
