Hot Lunch Count:

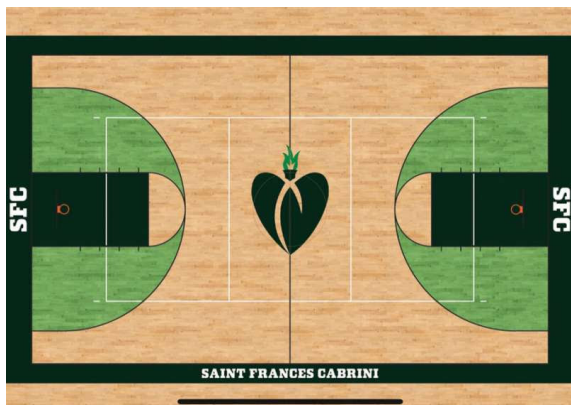

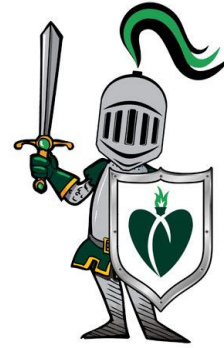
Tax Season

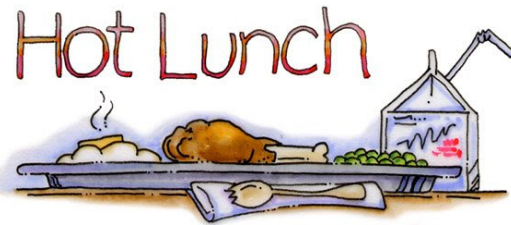
